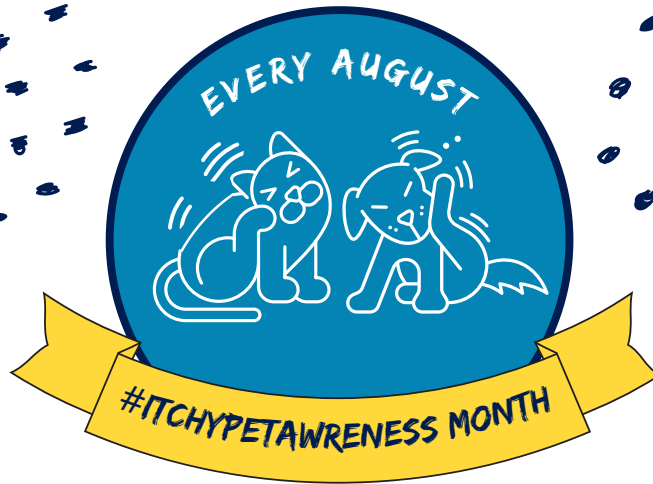




THE 'TELL-TAIL' SIGNS OF ALLERGIC ITCH

Ear problems



Hair loss

Body odor



Skin changes,
