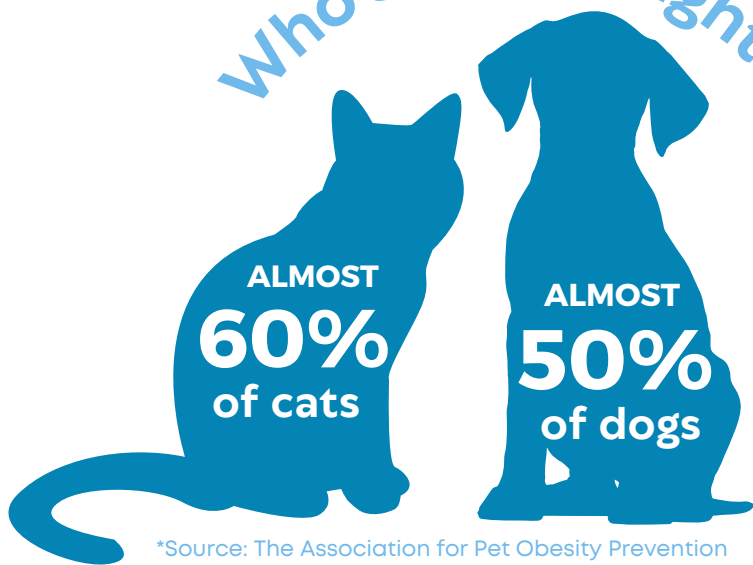

How can I tell if my pet is overweight?

Your regular veterinary health care team can determine your pet's **body condition score (BCS)** on a scale of 1-5 (3 being normal), provide an estimated ideal body weight, and recommend a veterinary-formulated diet to help with a healthy and safe weight and body condition for your pet.

Obesity shortens a pet's life and increases their risks to develop the following diseases and problems:

- Cancer
- Diabetes mellitus
- Heart disease and hypertension
- Osteoarthritis and faster degeneration of affected joints
- Urinary bladder stones
- Anesthetic complications, increased surgery time and costs
