## May 7, 2024

UNAPPROVED MINUTES: The Hamlin County Board of Commissioners met on May 7,2024 with the following members present: Rudebusch, Noem, Tulson, Saathoff and Roe. No one absent. Also present was John Delzer States Attorney.

The Chairman led the Board in the Pledge of Allegiance.

AGENDA: Motion by Saathoff seconded by Roe to approve the agenda as posted. All members voting Aye. Motion Carried.

MINUTES: Motion by Noem seconded by Roe to approve the minutes of April 16,2024 All members voting Aye. Motion Carried.

HIGHWAY DEPT: Bryan Pedersen Highway Supt met with the Board. He stated the Sioux Rural Water lines by the overhead bridge project have to be moved at a cost of 24,637.00 Motion by Noem seconded by Tulson to approve this. All members voting aye. Motion Carried. In order to continue this project two railroad crossings will have to be closed. There is no train that goes through this. To do this the county will have to purchase one acre of land from Harold Singrey. Motion by Roe seconded by Noem to purchase this one acre for up to 10,000 All members voting Aye. Motion Carried. In order to do this a plat will have to be applied for and title insurance. Commissioner Roe had contacted the DOT which Matt called in by phone. The Board was requesting turning lane be put at the intersection by Hwy 81 and Hwy 22 which comes from Hazel. This had been requested when the overlay project was done on Hwy 22. This is very dangerous for traffic pulling out and has a great deal of truck traffic. There have been several accidents and three people were killed there. Matt had contacted the State but they did not feel the need for it. The Board stated that the other turning lanes on Hwy 81 were on flat areas and not many accidents. Matt suggested contacting the Highway Safety Engineer Dustin Witt in Pierre and the Director of Planning . The States Attorney and Bryan will draw up a letter to be signed by the Board members to send to Pierre.

RESOLUTION: Motion by Noem seconded by Roe to pass the following RESOLUTION TO DELETE BRIDGE FROM NBI: The Hamlin County Board of Commissioners is in agreement with SD DOT that the following structure should be deleted from the National Bridge Inventory location of 3.5 W and 2.1 S of Hazel Structure 29-020-051 Structure has been removed as part of PCN 08NK and will be replaced by an at grade RR crossing. Taser X26 for 50.00 Fujitsu computer and Docking Station 400.00 Intoximeter SFST 50.00 and a Stalker Radar Unit for 500.00 Total cost \$1,000.00 if Dept bought these items new would cost about \$6,045.00 Motion by Roe seconded by Saathoff to purchase this equipment from Hayti Town. All members voting Aye. Motion Carried. Tayt also presented a quarterly report of traffic violations, crashes and calls for service stats.

PUBLIC COMMENT: Cheslie Gustafson Janitor met with the Board with quotes for different lawn mowers. The Board also gave her some quotes they had received. The Board approved the purchase of a new riding lawn mower and told her to try out the different kinds. The old mower will go out to the Highway Dept to use.

ZONING: Luke Muller of First District called in to meet with the Board. He feels the fee being charged for an appeal to the Zoning Board should be changed. The zoning officer was suggesting 500.00 for an appeal. The Board stated to set the fee at 250.00 Discussion was held on zoning regulations. Motion by Noem seconded by Roe to allow the Zoning Board to waive a fee if they deem it necessary. All members voting Aye. Motion Carried.
