MINUTES: Motion by Noem seconded by Saathoff to approve the minutes of Nov. 21,2023 All members voting Aye. Motion Carried.

EXECUTIVE SESSION: Motion by Roe seconded by Noem to go into executive session at 9:30 am for personnel reasons SDCL 1-25-2 (1) All members voting aye. Motion Carried. The Chairman declared them out at 9:45

HIGHWAY DEPT: Bryan Pedersen Highway Supt met with the Board. He said the State will take bids Dec. 6 on the tearing down of the overhead bridge. He requested permission for the highway dept employees to attend a safety meeting in Watertown on Jan. 30-31 which is paid by the insurance company. This is a required course. The Board approved such. He stated that Lamb Motors in Onida have state bids on pickups. The State had ordered more than they needed so these were available at State Bid prices for first come basis. He would like to try and purchase a half ton pickup. He would then surplus his 1992 pickup with 320,000 mileage and a 2001 pickup that has 322,000 mileage on it. The Board thought maybe to order one half ton Ford and one three-quarter ton Chevrolet. Bryan called the half ton pickups are already gone. The Board stated to let Hayti Town surplus it to sell as the County does not wish to purchase it at this time. He stated he is on the list at Lamb Motors for a new vehicle.

NACO PAYMENT: NACO worked hard to get 64 of our 66 counties at least 100,000 each of money to use as the county sees fit. The LACTF dollars were to be used to help those counties that have public lands and don't receive any property tax dollars on such. NACO is asking for 1% or 1000.00 to establish a Center for Public Lands. If the county does not pay such the SDACC will have to cover these costs.
