Details:

The past week, the Hamlin County Sheriff's Office has arrested three individuals for driving under the influence (DUI). Two of the DUI arrests were cannabis related.

On Sunday, July 20th, 2025, at 1:50am, near the intersection of SD Highway 28 and US Highway 81 (about three miles north of Lake Poinsett), a sheriff's deputy stopped a vehicle. A 28 year old Lake Norden man was arrested for DUI and Open Container. A Preliminary Breath Test at the scene was over double the legal limit under state law.

On Monday, July 21st, 2025, at 11:19pm, a sheriff's deputy stopped a vehicle on US Highway 81 at Lake Poinsett. A 47 year old Stockholm man was arrested for DUI, Possession of Controlled Substances, Illegal Possession of Marijuana, and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

On Thursday, July 24th, 2025, at 4:57pm, a sheriff's deputy stopped a vehicle on County Road 192 near 464th Avenue just northwest of Estelline. An 18 year old Tea man was arrested for DUI, Ingest Substance to Become Intoxicated, Illegal Possession of Marijuana, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, and Speeding.
