UNAPPROVED MINUTES: The Hamlin County Board of Commissioners met on Dec. 2, 2025 with the following members present: Rudebusch, Saathoff, Tulson, Buck and Popham. No one absent. John Delzer States Attorney was also present.

The Chairman led the Board in the Pledge of Allegiance.

AGENDA: Motion by Saathoff seconded by Buck to approve the agenda as posted. All members voting Aye. Motion carried.

MINUTES: Motion by Buck seconded by Popham to approve the minutes of Nov. 18,2025 All members voting Aye. Motion Carried.

HIGHWAY DEPT: Bryan Pedersen Hwy Supt met with the Board. Adam from IMEG was also present and went over the bridge inspections he had just completed. Depending on the size of the bridge some have to be inspected every year, some every two years and cement ones every four years. No changes were noted in the conditions of such. Some are posted for weight restrictions and the Hwy Supt maintains signs to show such. He had prepared the paperwork to submit for the bridge grant program. Bryan stated the new grader is ready for use. Just need to put the radio in. He requested to purchase a water pressure washer ALKOTA 430XM4 3.6 gpm 3000 psi for 7365.00 from Proline Watertown. Motion by Buck seconded by Scott to allow him to purchase such because this is the size that would be required. All members voting Aye. Motion Carried. Bryan stated the transmission repairs ended up being 52,315.

Motion by Tulson seconded by Saathoff to pass the following 2026 Bridge Improvement Grant Program Resolution authorizing submission of Applications. WHEREAS, Hamlin County SD wishes to submit applications for consideration of award for the Bridge Improvement Grant Program: STRUCTURE NUMBER AND LOCATIONS: 29-270-144 – 2.0 W & 1.6 N of Estelline SD and 29-277-140-1.3W & 2.0 N of Estelline SD and WHEREAS Hamlin County SD certifies that the projects are listed in the county's Five Year County Highway and Bridge Improvement Plan and WHEREAS Hamlin County SD agrees to pay the 20% match on the Bridge Improvement Grant funds and 100% of ineligible expenses: and WHEREAS Hamlin County SD hereby authorizes the Bridge Improvement Grant applications and any required funding commitments. PUBLIC COMMENT: No public comment was received.

FIRST DISTRICT: Todd Kays Executive Director and Jessica Tesch Planner met with the Board to submit their annual report. First District handles 11 counties and 76 communities. Hamlin County and Municipal Grants for fiscal year 2025 amounted to 1,054,084 They have handled 159 building permits for Hamlin County with an estimated value of construction 55,740,858 The total revenue taken in for building permits and board actions was 132,204 Total Zoning Office expense was 55,706.99 They submitted their fee list with a request to change starting Jan. 1,2026 for a Plat \$50.00 for Admin Fee and \$50 per lot and for a Subdivison Preliminary Plan \$200.00+ \$50.00 per lot charge .They also submitted the dates of zoning meetings for 2026.Motion by Saathoff seconded by Buck to approve the list of zoning fees and the zoning board meeting dates. All members voting Aye. Motion Carried.

4-H ADVISOR: Abbi Rogness 4-H Advisor met with the Board. She presented the Memorandum of Understanding between SDSU and Hamlin County of SD for 2026 Motion by Saathoff seconded by Buck to authorize the Chairman to sign such. All members voting Aye. Motion Carried. She requested permission to attend a training in Huron on Dec. 4 The Board approved such. She went through costs and what is needed with trying to get a new building at the 4-H grounds. There is a committee who meets considering what is needed and she is working to get some plans drawn up for bid letting. She stated 4-H Shooting Sports starts on Jan. 18 and goes through April. They still do not know about the City building which they had previously used. The cost they would have to pay the city for heating it would be a lot. Castlewood Shooting Range could handle the Shooting Sports two nights a week and could also supply some equipment. They would charge 150.00 per 4-Her which between the families and Shooting Sports money account this could probably be handled. There would probably be about 20 4-Hers doing this program. They also have two more new instructors taking the training now.
