UCC Manager's message

Towards Strengthening Internationalization of Education

Today, we are living in a vastly different world from what we have once experienced and lived. While we are compelled to seek a new normal, the bedrock of faith and vision on which the Union Christian College was founded remain unshaken by the transient turbulence of our time, calling us to work towards a new world of God's promise and a new humanity. As the College is moving towards its centennial, its alumni have a great responsibility to enable it to remain grounded in some of its cherished values.

In these times when education is increasingly becoming commercialized and it is no longer a part of the mission of Christ for churches of all denominations, rather a respectable venture to make profit, institutions like U C College can survive and remain true to its calling only with the help of its alumni who share its ecumenical vision of unity in witnessing to the Love of God, irrespective of our religious affiliation.

Organizations like UCCAANA holds much hope and remains a model to be followed for other alumni groups elsewhere in the world. I am proud to have been part of the initial thinking of constituting an alumni group in the United States during my visits in the 1990s. Two significant people with whom I had much contact at the time were Dr. Thomas P. Mathew and Late Dr. K. C. Chacko. Though, I was not attached to the UCC in an official capacity then, I did share with them my deep concern for UCC. Since then, the years have gone by like an ever - rolling stream. Let me pay my homage to the memory of Dr. K. C. Chacko and also another distinguished alumnus, Dr. George K. Zachariah, who had spent long years of his life in the US as a Professor at many Universities in the US, for their love and concern for the College

Development Office and Alumni Office are novel to higher educational institutions in Kerala. Moreover, many private colleges can sustain themselves without any alumni support as they are lush with financial resources, often accrued under the table during admissions and appointments, thereby feeding the public perception that colleges do not have any financial difficulties and have enough revenue. The Union Christian College, however, is an exception. It has no such revenue to rely on and has always remained content with its modest means as it has been the case throughout its history. Yet, it had never been put to shame or penury; it has been satisfied with what it has. In short, we only have our alumni to approach, even when we have not done enough to appeal to their sentiments. Though late Dr. K. C. Chacko insisted on establishing a Development Office, we have been able to do so only now. Hence, we would like to encourage you and your other alumni friends to be part of the rich data base that we have begun to put together, to facilitate the work of the Development Office, and to encourage many of our younger alumni to be part of UCCAANA.

Those of you who had distinguished in academics could help UCC connect with other Universities and Colleges in the US and identify and promote new vistas of cooperation. The International House is expected to be a nodal agency for such initiatives that further greater traffic of knowledge and international collaborations and exchanges.

The first and the largest endowment in the history of the college was made by the children of Late Vidwan P. G. Nair in the United States. The first instalment of Rs. 11 Lakhs was transferred in 2000 through the Presbyterian Church,

USA and another Rs. 14 lakhs was transferred through the UCCAANA in 2007. The interest accruing annually from the fund is used to provide research fellowships and loan scholarships. Since 2007, under the auspices of the endowment, the Vidwan P. G. Nair Memorial Research Centre of the Department of Malayalam has been annually conducting a comprehensive literary and cultural festival over the course of three days. I have highlighted the unstinting contribution of this alumni family to only show that the secret of generosity does not depend on the purse but a heart brimming with gratitude.

So this is a time to celebrate. Distance is no longer a problem. We will broadcast all the celebrations associated with the centenary to your homes with the help of digital technology. We would only request that you kindly make an effort to keep in touch with us. Yes, may we all wake up to a bright and beautiful morning ---.










Professor George K, Zachariah Passed Away on Dec. 31, 2020 at Vienna, Virginia, USA

Professor George K. Zachariah was a gentle giant who had celebrated his 90th birthday on 23rd November 2020 with his family and friends. A Festschrift titled "Christian Maturity: Freedom and Responsibility" was released by Most. Revd. Dr. Theodosius Mar Thoma Metropolitan of Malankara Mar Thoma Syrian Church via Zoom during the Navaho celebrations held on Nov. 23, 2020. We thank God for this humble servant of God.

Professor George Zachariah is a well-known and distinguished figure who has made excellent contributions in various areas of the ministry, administration and building ecumenical relationship of the Mar Thoma Church with other churches. His contributions in the academic fields of philosophy, psychology, theology and education both in India and in the USA are extensive and outstanding.

He hails from the Kuzhikkalakannimel family of Karthikappally in Kerala. He was born on 23rd November 1930. After his University education from the UC College, Alwaye, and the Madras Christian College, he started his teaching career at the UC College. While in Kerala he gave leadership for a host of Christian undertakings including the Student Christian Movement, the Mar Thoma Youth Leagues and the Mar Thoma student conferences.

He immigrated to the United States in 1958, and has been living in the Greater Washington area since 1972. He is survived by his wife, Susan, who is a graduate in Economics from the Kerala University



and has gained postgraduate qualifications from the University of North Carolina. He is also survived by George Abe Zachariah (son), Bindhu, Noah and Jayan, Elizabeth Zachariah Varghese (daughter), John, Eva and Maya, Varghese Mohan Zachariah (son), Susan, Josiah, Nathan and Alysha.

He is one of the founding members of the Mar Thoma Church of Greater Washington in 1980; prior to this he was involved in the ecumenical Christian activities from 1973. He then moved to the formation of one of the earliest Mar Thoma parishes in the USA, in Greater Washington. He was also totally involved in the development of the diaspora Mar Thoma communities in other cities and towns of the United States. He served as Diocesan Council member and also ad Editor of the 'Mar Thoma Messenger' official publication of the Diocese of North America and Europe of the Mar Thoma Church. It is to his wise counsel people turned for advice and help in those early and difficult years. He gave leadership for establishing the annual family conference and also publishing the Messenger, and was one its early editors. It is on the foundations that he helped to lay and build that we now have a coherent and vibrant Mar Thoma community in the USA. He contributed much for all the areas of the lives of the Mar Thoma Christians. He also taught for a year at the Mar Thoma Theological Seminary at Kottayam.

His holds a large number of graduate and postgraduate qualifications in theology, philosophy and education from a number of prestigious Universities in the USA including Princeton. His CV is over 33 pages, which lists most of his contributions and achievements over the last seventy years. He is a prolific writer and speaker on a variety of subjects. He published a number of books including a unique one, 'The Four Gospel in One', in 2000 with a foreword from Alexander Mar Thoma Metropolitan. There are a number of unpublished manuscripts of books in his library with a wealth of scholarship, which is kept under continuous review for future publication.

It is his total submission, and not holding back, to the will of God made Professor Zachariah who he was. Let us thank God for the faithful life of this vibrant, peace loving and loveable prophetic lay leader of the Mar Thoma Church. It is our hope and faith that we shall meet with our loved ones for an eternal life in heaven with our Lord. May the Lord comfort with his everlasting peace which surpasses all human understanding the bereaved family, relatives and friends at this time.

Remembering MM By Bhamini M. P. Nayar, Ph.D. (PDC, B.Sc. (Mathematics) and M. Sc. (Mathematics), 1967-1974)

I can count a lot of blessings in my life. The guidance and nurturing I received from my parents and siblings early in life, and from a good number of dedicated and committed teachers later in life were invaluable. All those guided me through and prepared me to be where I am right now. They all are educators of life, every step of the way. Among my teachers who left an indelible mark in my training, Madhavankutty Sir, MM, is at the top of the list. To a young girl in the PDC class at UCC, coming from a local high school, college atmosphere was new and intimidating. However, the presence of eminent professors such as MM, Nambiar Sir (EN), David J. Daniel Sir (DJD), Neelakantan Sir (NSN), Thomas Philip Sir (TP), T. B. Thomas Sir (TBT), etc., made the transition to higher education much easier. Later when I chose a career path as an educator in mathematics, that move felt natural. Those teachers are my role models.

MM and NSN are the two teachers who taught me for 7 years, for PDC, B.Sc and M.Sc, in Mathematics. I always remember my teachers' invaluable guidance throughout my education. Above all, it was reassuring that MM's enduring affection and trust lasted through the years even after I graduated with my M. Sc.. Every time I went back home, I managed to see MM; either he would come to my home, or (after he retired) I would go to his home. We would discuss his busy life after retirement, talk about education systems here and at home. In addition to mathematics, we discussed Malayalam poetry and lots of other things. During those conversations, often he would affectionately talk about other students and even remember where in the classroom those particular students used to sit, etc. He was that involved as an educator. I do not mean just



as a Mathematics professor, but he was truly an educator of life itself. If his busy schedule of activities did not provide an opportunity for me to see him, I at least made a point to talk to him over the phone. At least once or twice a year called him from here in USA. He would recognize the voice and no introduction was necessary.

It is hard to believe that his calm, measured and reassuring voice is no more. Even in his last recorded message for the centenary celebration of the college, there was no hint that, that voice was going to be silent very soon. While being frank in his assessment and opinion, I do not remember any time when he spoke ill about anyone.

A life well lived is a lesson for all; his dedication to actions, actions which brought light to lives is a lesson worth emulating; his life rich with love and affection from his students and others, is to be aspired. MM, my Pranamam.


Mathew, and their families.


