







PIEDMONT ODYSSEY OF THE MIND 2025-2026

THINK CREATIVELY!

Through solving open-ended problems, students develop creative-thinking skills that can be applied to real-life situations. Each year, tens of thousands of students take part in Odyssey of the Mind, the original STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Math) education program established in 1978. Schools and organizations form teams of five to seven students in the fall. The students work developing a solution to their selected long-term problem, which varies from building mechanical devices such as spring-driven vehicles to engineering weight bearing balsa wood structures to giving their own interpretation of literary classics. Each problem comes with specific guidelines including a cost limit, time limit, and scoring rubric. All aspects of the solution including costumes, props, scenery, and technical devices must be original creations of the students. The teams present their solutions at a regional and a state tournament that is hosted by the Oklahoma State University Honors College. The day of competition, teams also receive a secret spontaneous problem which emphasizes teamwork and quick-thinking. In the last three years alone, Oklahoma State University has awarded over \$75,000 in scholarships to high school students celebrating their successes at the state tournament. The top teams at the state tournament advance to compete at World Finals and meet up with thousands of students from across the United States and dozens of countries around the world!
