RESIDENT MEMBERSHIP is open to all households residing within and/or owning property within the following boundaries:

1 The southerly side of Highland Road, from the corner of Route 18, proceeding west along Highland Road to Route 140 south.

2 The easterly side of Route 140 to County Road, the easterly side of County Road, proceeding south along County Road crossing the Freetown line, to Mason Road.

3 The northerly side of Mason Road, proceeding east to Route 18. The westerly side of Route 18, proceeding north to Bedford Street. 4 The southerly side of Bedford Street, proceeding northwest to Highland Road.

ASSOCIATED MEMBERSHIP is open to anyone who wants to be involved and support the efforts of the Long Pond Association yet is not a resident. This membership can make suggestions, yet does not have any voting rights.
