HREC4DV is dedicated to advancing equity and economically empowering those affected by domestic violence through individualized educational programs, financial assistance, skills development, awareness, financial coaching, basic needs assistance, resources, and emotional and spiritual support groups.

Our Story

Founded in June 2019 as a support group, HREC4DV has grown into a movement advocating for change and supporting equity in the lives of domestic violence survivors. Our journey underscores that a combination of resources, education, support, and compassion leads to successful outcomes.

2024 Impact Highlights

- **Community Reach:** Since our inception, we've directly supported over 23,000 individuals annually, providing not only food but also the resources necessary for long-term success.
- **Noble Plate Program**: Served over 15,600 hot meals annually to homeless individuals and families in need, addressing immediate nutritional needs and fostering community connections.
- Women's Resource Assistance: Assisted 720 women annually with vital resources, including case management, food assistance, and job readiness programs, empowering them towards independence.
- **Annual Community Events**: Hosted events such as the Annual Community Baby Shower, Thanksgiving Meal Distribution, and Christmas Toy Distribution
- Employment Readiness Programs: Offered mentorship and life skills lessons, preparing survivors to reenter the workforce with the confidence and skills needed for sustainable employment.
- **Cycle of Healing**: Survivors who regain their strength through our programs often go on to support other victims within our organization, creating a powerful cycle of healing and empowerment.
