From humble beginnings in 2012, Sheng Tai International (STI) has grown into one of Malaysia's most innovative and sustainable companies. Founder and chairman Dato' Leong Sir Ley established the company amid a global financial crisis. During the Coronavirus pandemic in 2020, Dato' Leong persevered to overcome the pandemic and grow her symphony by introducing STI's 4 main initiatives which are Fashion, Wellness, Artificial Intelligence, and Art & Culture.

With its headquarters located in the bustling city of Petaling Jaya, Selangor, an overseas office was set up in Hong Kong in 2012. STI further extended its global reach by setting up offices in Shanghai (2019), Beijing (2020), Tokyo (2020), and Osaka (2023).


What started out as a property consultancy company soon transposed into a business that rewrote the failing projects of others and composed them into grand pieces. Sheng Tai International further defined its core businesses and developed different sections as well as its various different subsidiaries.

SHARING OUR MUSIC

Over the years, Sheng Tai International has expanded at a rapid pace with 6 offices in Malaysia, Japan, China, and Hong Kong SAR. The company has also ventured into the Middle East, Singapore, Indonesia, Taiwan, the UK, and much more. With its years of experience, STI has managed to perform some rather impressive symphonies with its 500 employees.



In 2016, STI took over the abandoned MITC development in Melaka from its previous developer and transposed it into an economic contributor with hotels, serviced residences, and retail. AMES Hotel and Hotel MetraSquare were also set up there in 2019. With AMES Hotel being a 5-star hotel, it has seen many locals and foreigners and hosted plenty government events.





GOES ON

Five years on and STI hasn't shown any signs of slowing down. With major developments such as the 6.1-acre Regalia Beachfront Residence in Tanjung Kling, Melaka, or the 38 storey NOVO luxury apartment in Kuala Lumpur, and even the multifaceted crown jewel of STI, The Sail which will consist of 9 unique towers at an estimated GDV of RM6.5 billion. STI has also been making deals with some of the world's top companies and market leaders all while enchanting them to set up business at The Sail in Melaka.

And so, within just over a decade, STI has grown at a rapid pace in hospitality, wellness, artificial intelligence and even fashion divisions. And based on what we've seen with STI's business deals and upcoming projects, Dato' Leong and her orchestra don't plan on slowing the tempo of their symphony.







THE COMPOSER AND ITS MUSE

The project which is the composition of Dato' Leong Sir Ley, the chairman and founder of Sheng Tai International [STI], will take advantage of the ambitious Belt and Road Initiative (OBOR) by the Chinese government which looks to improve economic and cultural connectivity among Asian, European, and African nations. The Sail itself looks to bring new businesses and key global players to Melaka and re-write it as a global city.







A CHOIR OF A THOUSAND VOICES

One of the biggest companies that will be making its way to The Sail is the Karl Lagerfeld group which struck a deal with STI in early 2023, Karl Lagerfeld group will occupy The Sail's fashion tower. This tower will be designed by the Karl Lagerfeld designers and will house the 360° elliptical-shaped moon theatre, Karl Lagerfeld's luxury hotel and residences as well as STI's own Straits Designer Gallery.

Besides that, Hong Kong actress Michele Reis has purchased a tower at The Sail. The M Tower will house many luxury amenities and facilities as well as luxury residences and penthouses all while carrying an Indochine design theme through it.

Another tower at this iconic development will be dedicated to Sheng Tai International's other business. The wellness tower will be under the companies' wellness subsidiary, Sheng Life. The tower will be a source of development for preventative medicine, anti-aging and stem cell treatment with over 60 Japanese doctors and stem cell specialists who will transfer their expertise to local medical experts.

Other towers like the AI tower will be the solo act for the advancement of AI technology with the help of various AI companies from around the world. There will also be an Art & Culture Tower which is poised to be the cultural centre of Malaysia. The tower will showcase the history of Melaka as well as art & culture from around the world in its galleries.








THE SOLOIST

At its base will be the largest shopping mall in Melaka that boasts 1 million sqft of retail space. This mall will also possess impressive features such as an indoor canal with a modern interpretation of Melaka, a 100,000 sqft Ski Centre & Snow Park with a 21m ski slope, and a waterfall that flows from the top of the shopping mall.

OVERTURE



The Straits Designers' Gallery (SDG), a fashion platform that aims to showcase local designers' fashion works while collaborating with international fashion brands to label Melaka as the next international fashion capital in the east. Fully owned by Sheng Tai International, SDG has composed a number of events such as the Straits Gala Malaysia which began in 2021.

It later composed the annual Straits Gala in January 2023 that took place at The Sail Superdome. With over 1000 overseas investors and guests in attendance, the gala presented designs from the SDG and University Technology Mara's designers. It also served as an evaluation platform for F Academy trained models.

As fashion is something that Dato' Leong is highly passionate about, STI looked to writing a masterpiece with a big name in the fashion industry. And in February 2023, STI and Karl Lagerfeld group penned a deal to have Karl Lagerfeld group set up their first luxury hotel in The Sail.

The two groups will also work closely with architects to design The Sail's fashion tower.


STI has also set up the F Academy which will serve to nurture the talents in modelling. The Academy has already conducted auditions since April 2023 which saw it receive an overwhelming response.


