TOWN CRIER SNOW REMOVAL PLAN

Snow storm procedures: PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

- The plow will clear area #1 first.
- Units 1-12 will move their wehicles to area #1 and their spaces will be cleared. When the plows are finished clearing 1-12 those units will move their vehicles back.
- 3. Units 13-28 and any vehicles parked in area #2 will move to area #1 then move back when finished.
- Units 29-40 will move to areas #1 & #2 for their spaces to be cleared, then move back when finished.
- 5. Units 57-68 and all vehicles in the parking area by the lower entrance will move to areas #1.8.#2 for their spaces to be cleared. Units 57-68 will move back when finished. The lower parking area will remain open as a snow area.
- Units 41-56 will move to areas #1 & #2 for their spaces to be cleared then move back when finished.
 IMPORTANT NOTES
 - We will try to have the plows sound their horns a few minutes before they intend to clear your area.
 - It is essential that no cars be left overnight in area #1.
 - If you plan to be away, please make arrangements to have your vehicle moved at the appropriate time.
 - 4. According to the Town Crier Rules and Regulations, Unit Owners/Tenants whose vehicles impede snow removal are subject to a \$5.00 fine per vehicle, for each offense for not cooperating with the snow removal effort. Unit owners may be charged for the extra time it takes to plow around vehicles that are not moved promptly. Be ready to move your vehicle at the appropriate time do not wait for someone to knock at your door. Any vehicle blocking a snow storage area or any vehicle not moved from a designated parking space may be towed at the discretion of the Board at the owners' expense.
 - For the most efficient and cost effective removal of snow it is essential that you move your vehicle at the correct time and then move it back immediately after the plows have finished with your area.
