The Phillips County Historical Society, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit corporation, was incorporated with the state of Colorado on November 16, 1967. It is a group of volunteers that have a mission to preserve and protect the history of Phillips County and northeast Colorado, and they play an important role in the governorship of the Phillips County Museum. The PCHS Board of Directors is elected from the membership and effectively serves as the Museum Board. PCHS members receive a subscription to the Phillips County Museum newsletter and have voting privileges at the PCHS annual meeting.

The museum's collection includes artifacts depicting farm and ranch life, domestic life, automobiles, businesses and organizations, school activities, and much more. The museum grounds also house a Reimer-Smith filling station, which is on the National Register of Historic Places, and a one-room schoolhouse from the Pleasant Prairie District southwest of Holyoke.

Membership funds help sponsor special activities and programs and are used to help purchase needed items for the preservation of the collection housed at the Phillips County Museum. A strong, supportive membership enables the organization to continue to thrive and fulfill its mission of preserving the county's history. We would love to have the doors open more often and expand and create new exhibits, but we need more funds to do so.
