Project Overview

The City of La Grulla seeks to enter a professional services contract for the management, operation, and maintenance of its municipal water and sewer systems. These facilities are vital to the health, safety, and economic growth of the community and must be operated in compliance with all applicable regulations, particularly those established by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ).

The facilities to be managed, operated, and maintained include:

- Water System:
- La Grulla Water Plant No. 1
- La Grulla Water Plant No. 2
- Alto Bonito Elevated Storage Tank
- La Victoria Standpipe
- River Pump Station
- Sewer System:
- La Grulla Wastewater Treatment Plant
- Eight (8) Lift Stations

I. Scope of Work

The selected contractor will:

- Maintain and operate the City's water and sewer systems in full compliance with all applicable TCEQ regulations.
- Provide a minimum of two (2) licensed operators per shift at the La Grulla Water Plant facilities (Plant No. 1 and Plant No. 2) to cover three (3) shifts per day, 24 hours per day,

seven (7) days per week, 365 days per year.

- Provide a minimum of two (2) licensed operators for the Wastewater Treatment Plant to cover the day shift, seven (7) days per week, 365 days per year.
- Operate and maintain the following facilities:
- Water Plant No. 1 and Water Plant No. 2
- Alto Bonito Elevated Storage Tank
- La Victoria Standpipe
- River Pump Station
- Wastewater Treatment Plant
- Eight (8) Lift Stations
- Perform daily operational checks, water quality sampling, and process control testing.
- Conduct residual monitoring and required monthly Bac-T and TCEQ compliance testing.
- Maintain thorough records of system operations, testing results, and maintenance activities.
- Submit all required compliance reports, including but not limited to:
- Monthly TCEQ reports
- DMRs (Discharge Monitoring Reports)
- Annual Reports
- Plant operation logs
- Provide timely emergency response and corrective maintenance to ensure uninterrupted service and compliance.
- Collaborate with City leadership on system improvements, regulatory updates, and future capital planning needs.

II. Proposal Requirements

Proposals should include, at a minimum:

- Company profile and qualifications.
- List of key personnel and their licenses/certifications.
- Demonstrated experience in water and wastewater system management, operations, and maintenance for municipalities of similar size and complexity.

- Description of organizational capacity to perform services, including staffing levels,

24/7 coverage capability, equipment availability, and financial capacity.

- References from municipalities or public entities served.

- Detailed staffing plan showing coverage for three (3) shifts at the Water Plants and

River Pump Station, and two (2) operators for the Wastewater Treatment Plant day shift.

- Proof of required insurance (Worker's Compensation, Commercial General Liability,

Business Automobile Liability).

III. Term

- The City is seeking a one (1) year term contract.

- The City prefers to include a provision for one (1) extension for an equal period of time

at the discretion of the City.

- Proposed escalation factors will be taken into price consideration.

IV. Evaluation Criteria

Proposals will be evaluated and ranked according to the following main criteria (total of 100 points):

- Experience / Previous Work Performance: 40 points

- Capacity to Perform: 20 points

- Best Value to the City: 20 points

- Previous Experience with the City: 20 points

Additional Evaluation Categories (Scored Separately):

- Price: 20 points

- Local Presence (Company has principal place of business or satellite office in Starr

County): 10 points
