

Dear Horsemen,

As we begin the new racing season, this is a reminder of several important ORC requirements.

### **Veterinary Treatment Reporting**

All veterinary treatments must be reported using the attached Medication Report Form. Your treating veterinarians must:

- Report all treatments in writing on the approved form.
- Include the horse's name, trainer, medication or procedure, date and time, and any additional required information.
- Veterinarian must sign the form and file it **within 48 hours**, and no later than **post time** if the horse is entered.

Reports are confidential except when used in an official investigation or proceeding.

### **Injection Restrictions**

Intra-articular injections are **prohibited on race day**, within **14 days** of post time, and within **7 days** of any timed and recorded workout.

### **Incident Reporting & Necropsy**

Any time a horse dies on the track or association grounds, an **incident report must be completed**. The **ORC will arrange for the transport and necropsy** on all equine fatalities that occur on racing grounds under ORC's jurisdiction. ORC will reimburse the track for reasonable expenses of transportation.
