- 10 residents attended
- In addition to the agenda items the following topics were raised by the resident attendees
 - There was a request to post the names and addresses of the residents that are excessively delinquent in their dues.

 - Walking people don't know if there is an invisible fence when a dog is outside unattended
 - Lou stated they should call the police because there is a leash law, this is not something enforceable by the board
