_____ Adopter understands that Save A Life Pet Rescue, Inc. will also have FULL rights of revoking ownership of the animal if the animal is not being properly cared for medically or humanely.

_____ The breed of these animals is NOT guaranteed, since the rescued animals come to Save A Life Pet Rescue, Inc. with little to no background information.

_____ Adopter acknowledges that Save A Life Pet Rescue, Inc. does not guarantee the behavior or temperament of adopted animals. Further, the adopter acknowledges that animals should never be left unsupervised with children.

_____ By initializing here I am agreeing that the animal I am adopting appears to be in good health (clear eyes, dry nose and active). While Save A Life Pet Rescue Inc. would never knowingly adopt out a sick animal, the adopter understands these are rescue animals that come from deplorable situations. They could have a hidden illness that the rescuer, adopter, or the vet has not detected.

_____ Adopter understands that nearly all of the animals pulled from previous situations may have never had any medical attention (vaccines, deworming, flea and heartworm control, etc.). Because of this, there is always a possibility they have been exposed to various diseases prior to being vaccinated. Save A Life Pet Rescue, Inc. gives these animals a new start with their first two sets of vaccines, deworming, flea and heartworm prevention and spay or neuter.

_____ Adopter understands that Save A Life Pet Rescue, Inc. retains full discretion over the decision to cover the costs of any diagnostics or treatments after adoption.

_____ The adoption donation is ONLY refundable within 24 hours if the animal is returned to Save A Life Pet Rescue, Inc. Anytime thereafter, all adoption donations are

NON-REFUNDABLE. No Exceptions. **Please allow up to 72 hours to receive your refund.**

_____ Save A Life Pet Rescue Inc., will not be responsible for refunding any amount (medical included) over the adoption donation. No Exceptions.

_____ Any veterinarian that has performed the altering of an animal is NOT affiliated with Save A Life Pet Rescue, Inc. Therefore if any issues arise regarding these animals, the adopter agrees to ONLY contact Save A Life Pet Rescue, Inc.

_____ Adopter understands that many animal diseases, like human illnesses, can have an incubation period for up to several weeks before showing any signs or symptoms. Save A Life Pet Rescue, Inc. recommends separating newly adopted animals and other animals in the household for 7-14 days. Save A Life Pet Rescue, Inc. will not be responsible for any other animals in the household if they become ill.

_____ Adopter understands that there is no guarantee of a pet's health and behavior. Adopter understands that whatever preventative treatment given by Save A Life Pet Rescue, Inc. to protect the pet's health is not conclusive and the adopter may need to seek further precautionary treatment to ensure the pet's health. Adopter hereby agrees that he/she is financially able to take care for his/her newly adopted animal.

_____ Adopter understands illnesses common among house pets - such as distemper, canine parvovirus, and heartworms- can't spread to people. But some types of zoonotic diseases CAN be transmitted via a bite, scratch, animal waste, saliva, or dander. I do not hold Save A Life Pet Rescue liable if any such transferable illness may occur.

_____ Adopters understand they are financially responsible for any and all medical costs from the time of adoption moving forward.

_____ Adopters understand if a newly adopted pet tests positive for parvo within 7 days of adoption. Save A Life Pet Rescue, INC. will ONLY cover treatment if the pet is taken to Oviedo Veterinary Care and Emergency (24/7 Clinic)

_____ Adopter understands it's recommended to have any newly adopted pet established for a wellness exam within the first week of adoption. A FREE Exam and Fecal is available to all adopters at the **Oviedo Veterinary Care and Emergency**. Adopter acknowledges that all puppies are born with worms and it may take several rounds of deworming. Save A Life Pet Rescue, Inc. does give two doses of dewormer, however it is highly recommended to continue with two additional rounds of deworming at the adopter's expense.

_____ Save A Life Pet Rescue, Inc. feeds and recommends to feed Purina One Puppy or Authority Puppy (dry and wet) dog food. We advise the adopter not to change the pet's diet. Sudden changes in the diet can cause a pet to become seriously ill and may cause death.

_____ If at any time Save A Life Pet Rescue, Inc. has to notify an attorney about any legal matter regarding an adoption, the adopter will be responsible for any and all legal fees incurred.
