#### A WORD FROM THE DIRECTOR

Neil Simon created the original play, *The Odd Couple* in 1965, featuring the mismatched roommates Oscar and Felix. It ran on Broadway from 1965 to 1967 for a total of 964 performances and garnered several Tony nominations and awards. It was made into a movie in 1968 starring Jack Lemmon and Walter Matthau, who reprised his Broadway role. The show was adapted as a TV sitcom from 1970 to 1975, starring Jack Klugman and Tony Randall.

Twenty years later, Mr. Simon flipped the genders in his adaptation, *The Odd Couple - Female Version*, featuring the slovenly Olive and the uptight neatfreak Florence. The regular poker game of the original play has given way to a spirited game of Trivial Pursuit. When their worlds collide, hilarity ensues. The Broadway production opened in June 1985 and closed in February 1986 after 295 performances. That production starred Sally Struthers as Florence and Rita Moreno as Olive, later replaced by Brenda Vaccaro.

This production has been an absolute pleasure to create. I previously directed this show almost 30 years ago with my own company, but being able to work closely with Harry and this exceptional cast has taken the experience to a new level. I have always been fascinated with the creative process of transforming words on paper into an actual "reality". That, I feel, is the very essence of what it means to be an artist. My humble thanks go out to all who have been a part of this.
