

2018 Alberta Thai Association Scholarship Application Form

A limited number of scholarships are offered annually to active members of the Association who are entering, in their first year or are continuing full-time study in a diploma or degree program at a recognized public or private college, university or polytechnic institute. Applications must be made prior to or during the student attendance period. The Selection Committee will make recommendations to the Board for final decisions regarding the admissibility and granting of each scholarship.

A. Information for Applicants

1. Before applying for a scholarship, check the criteria for eligibility below to ensure that you:
 - are an ATA Member in good standing (Preference will be given to those with a minimum of 2 consecutive membership years.),
 - are entering, in your first year or are continuing full-time study in a diploma or degree program at a recognized public or private college, university or polytechnic institute;
 - have not previously received an Association scholarship.
2. Fill out the following form in full. **Faxed or emailed applications will not be accepted.**
3. Obtain and attach all required documentation as specified at the end of this form.
4. Applicants can choose **either** of the two deadlines for submitting applications:

Note to applicants enrolled in a post-secondary program: To be considered by the ATA Selection Committee, applications must be received prior to the completion of the program. Please insure that your nominee also meets the chosen deadline.

D. Required Documentation

In addition to completing this form, applicants must submit the additional documentation specified below for this scholarship. **Applications submitted without the required documentation will not be reviewed by the Selection Committee and will be rejected. If written proof of program registration is not available by the either of the application deadlines, the Selection Committee *may* accept late documentation if so notified with this application. Original documents and transcripts will be returned.**

- Official transcripts for all secondary, post-secondary and professional courses/programs you have completed.
- A Report/Nomination Form filled out by an ATA member describing reasons for your nomination.
- A letter of reference from a previous teacher, professor or instructor which describes your academic ability and characteristics as a student.
- Written proof that you are entering or are in a full-time diploma or degree program at a recognized public or private college, university or polytechnic institute. If written proof of program registration is not available by the July 31st or Heritage Days deadline, the Selection Committee **may** accept late documentation if so notified with this application.
