

PART 2

Welcome to Part 2 of the beginner guitar lessons. I hope you will enjoy it very much and learn a lot. This section is more suitable for young children who can already read.

It is very important that you first work through Part 1, because Part 2 builds onto Part 1.

I will show you each guitar chord very clearly, so listen and observe, and you will see that soon you will play guitar very well!

It is very important to practice each lesson's chords and songs very well before moving on to the next lesson. If you move too quickly to the next lesson, you might struggle, and playing won't be as fun anymore.

In this section, we will learn to play songs with 3 chords.

Since the chords will now follow each other more quickly, we will first do it a bit slower than the actual speed of the song. Practice each lesson's song with me at a slower tempo in the lesson. Once you can change your chords easily, you can move on to the actual speed of the song with the recorded song. Remember, you can also practice the songs without the lessons under the "Play and sing-along" Playlists.

The most important thing is that you should enjoy playing the guitar. You might struggle a little at first, but soon you'll be able to sing and play happily!



The 1st guitar chord we learned, was D for Doggy.




D MAJOR

The 2nd chord we learned, was A for Ant.



The 3rd chord we learned, was E for Eagle




