- 2) MEET IN THE BAND ROOM ON FRIDAY, OCTOBER 10th @

1:00pm

- 3) CONCERT UNIFORM: Wear your SciTech Band uniform shirt (and black pants if possible). If you don't have a uniform shirt, one will be provided, but you need to return it at the end of the performance or you will owe \$20.
- 4) PLAN AHEAD, BE ON TIME, BE READY TO FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS
- 5) USE THE BATHROOM BEFORE LEAVING SCHOOL (Even better, before your 4th block class!)
- 6) BRING YOUR INSTRUMENT
- 7) MUSIC: (1) Latin Groove, (2) 12 Bar Blues, and (3) Tempest
- 8) NO TALKING OR PLAYING DURING PERFORMANCE OR IN BETWEEN PIECES
- 9) STAND TALL & PROUD AT ALL TIMES
- 10) DO NOT LEAVE THE BAND AT ANYTIME WITHOUT PERMISSION
- 11) USE APPROPRIATE & ENCOURAGING LANGUAGE AT ALL TIMES
- 12) SAY THANK YOU TO BUS DRIVERS
- 13) SEEK TO SERVE & HELP PACK UP AT THE END OF THE EVENT

Schedule

a) Set up equipment outside of Dorman during the day on Friday, October 10th

Select road crew meet in the band room @ 8:30am

1) 1:00: Meet in band room, get band shirt in room 106, change, get instrument, & go to buses. USE THE BATHROOM DURING THIS TIME!

2) 1:30: SciTech Band departs SciTech

3) 1:45: SciTech Band arrives @ Dorman (leave instrument cases on buses); students go to the field to wait QUIETLY for the performance. Talk through performance plan. Settle in.

4) 2:30: SciTech Band gets set in performance formation

5) 2:50:

- On cue, band begins playing "Latin Groove" and Dorman students are led outside one grade at a time, in parade fashion.
- Once all the students are outside, band finishes "Latin Groove" and plays "12 Bar Blues" (maybe "Tempest" before 12 Bar as well, if there is time).
- After band performs, transition to Bomba de Aquí. Students set instruments down and join the Dorman students for a dance party (somehow – pending preferences of Bomba de Aquí).

6) 3:30: Dismissal. SciTech Band plays "Latin Groove" again; vamps with solos. End with "Tempest."

7) 3:45: Once dismissal is over, SciTech Band eats pizza, then loads equipment into truck & boards the buses.

8) 4:00: SciTech Band departs Dorman

9) 4:10: SciTech Band arrives back at SciTech; leadership team unloads truck.
