



SCI-TECH BAND PERFORMS FOR GOVERNOR HEALEY'S INAUGURATION CELEBRATION @ BOSTON'S TD GARDEN

Event Description

Governor Maura Healey and Lt. Governor Kim Driscoll will hold their inaugural celebration at Boston's TD Garden! The "Moving the Ball Forward" celebration on January 5th will embrace the leaders' basketball careers and honor the barrier-breaking status of their administration. "This inauguration will be a celebration of teamwork, positivity and breaking barriers — and there's no better place to hold the event than at TD Garden," Healey said. "It's about looking forward to the future and engaging directly with people about how we can deliver for them across this Commonwealth." Driscoll said that "we hope that anyone who attends this celebration will feel proud of Massachusetts' history and excited about the bright future ahead." The event will feature the Abilities Dance Troupe, Todd Angilly, Boston Arts Academy, DJ Frenchie, Eddie Palladino, Everett Marching Band, Boston's Gay Men's Chorus, hip hop artist OOMPA, Witch Pitch Chorus, and Springfield's SciTech Band, *The Pride of Springfield!*

8:15am

3) CONCERT UNIFORM: Wear your SciTech Band uniform shirt (and black pants). If you don't have a uniform shirt, one will be provided, but you need to return it at the end of the performance, or you will owe \$20.

4) BRING A WARM JACKET FOR WALKING OUTSIDE

5) EXTRA SPENDING MONEY IS OPTIONAL: You will be given \$15 for an early dinner at Faneuil Hall in Boston— you are welcome to bring more money for food, but it is not required.

15) 4:45pm: Line up for SciTech performance

16) 5:00pm: All performances begin, SciTech performs first—opening show

17) 5:20pm: Following performance, quickly return to the warm-up room & put instruments away

18) 5:30pm: Eat dinner quickly & clean up

19) 5:50pm: Go to assigned seats and watch the program (remain quiet)

20) 6:30pm: Official Ceremony, Speeches, & Governor Speech

21) 8:00pm: Band returns to warm-up room, packs up; Leader road crew packs equipment

1) Enter stage (Row 1 - Saxes, Row 2 - Saxes & Flutes, Row 3 - Flutes & Clarinets, Row 4 - Clarinets & Tpts, Row 5 - Tpts, Row 6 Tpts & Low Brass)

2) “And now, please welcome, from Springfield Massachusetts, the Pride of Springfield, the SciTech Band!”

3) Tweet--Tweet--Tweet--Tweet

4) **Drum Feature** (Turn on finger lights) – Optional: Add “Go SciTech Cheer”

5) Tweet---Tweet---Da-ga-da-ga-dut...Da-ga-da-ga-dut...**Go SciTech!**

6) **Cheer** (with instruments up high)

7) Tweet-----Tweet-----Tweet--Tweet--Tweet--Tweet

8) **Tempest** – Optional: Repeat
