- 1) THESE ARE MANDATORY PERFORMANCE FOR MTM MEMBERS
- 2) CONCERT UNIFORM: Wear your Zanetti Band uniform shirt to each performance. Shirts cost \$20. Please pay for your shirt if you haven't done so already. If you are unable to pay, speak to Mr. Bernice. We will make sure everyone has a Zanetti Band shirt.
- 3) PLAN AHEAD, BE ON TIME, BE READY TO FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS
- 4) USE THE BATHROOM BEFORE YOU LEAVE SCHOOL ON MAY 18th
- 5) BRING YOUR INSTRUMENT TO EACH PERFORMANCE
- 6) PREPARE MUSIC: (1) Cadence (buckets), (2) Hard Rock Blues, (2) C Minor Groove (with optional solos), (4) Tempest, (5) Benediction
- 7) NO TALKING OR PLAYING DURING PERFORMANCE OR IN BETWEEN PIECES
- 8) STAND/SIT TALL & PROUD AT ALL TIMES (Be prepared to stand at the final 2 performances)
- 9) DO NOT LEAVE THE BAND AT ANYTIME WITHOUT PERMISSION
