A Letter from  
the Director



After the frigid temperatures and snow-covered ground, I am overjoyed to see warmer temperatures and all that they promise. New life has begun sprouting forth. Green grass is beginning to grow, trees are showing their beautiful leaves, and many have begun seedlings in their house, preparing for the upcoming planting season. This reminds me of the Easter season. Jesus died on a cross and was buried in the tomb. It looked like a bleak, hopeless situation. But three days later, He arose with new life and now we have a hope and promise of the future to be with the Father. What an amazing, celebratory story we have!

Being back with the students after Christmas break has been such a blessing! With the help of the Duffie Bag Ministry, we were able to hand out Bibles to every student this year at Christmas time. My students were so excited to receive a Bible of their own that they would ask each week, "Is today the day we get to take home our Bibles?" Finally, the day had come and as we were handing them out, one student excitedly announced, "I am going to read this EVERY night!" We explained that it would be fun to read with their family as well (thus furthering the spread of the Gospel). At a different school, when returning from Christmas break, I asked the students if they were enjoying their Bibles. One student replied "I was... until my mom stole mine! She said she wanted to start reading it herself!" We were able to get that student another Bible; however, it does show us the innate desire for God's Word in the home and the need for His Word to be taught in the public schools.

Our students are hungry for the Word of God. We do have a significant number of students who know Him and use Weekday as a means of sharing their faith with one another and learning how to become missionaries in their school, but there is an extraordinary amount of students who before Weekday did not know who God is. We are entrusted with the blessing of sharing the Gospel with these students and we don't take this lightly. Our teachers prepare every week with prayer, and we ask that you lift up this ministry in your prayers as well. Would you consider donating a day every week to be in prayer over Weekday, our staff, and our students? Pray that God would open the minds of our students, let His Word fall on good ground to produce good fruit within each and every student listening, and that our teachers would be encouraged to keep doing the work of the Kingdom.

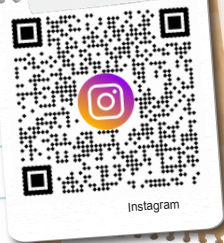


## What's Happening with Weekday

### Student Story:

Jennifer went on saying, 'We all laughed because it was the last day, but he got it!'"

"I would say the most rewarding thing about being a weekday teacher is the fact that I get to have a full circle moment and give back to my community, because I was a weekday kid," says Jennifer.

### What is your advice for someone thinking about becoming a Weekday teacher?

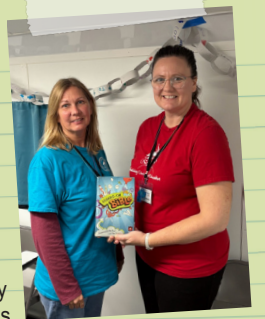
Here's what Jennifer said...

"We are the lights on the path of these kids' journeys to God. I want you to think of yourself as a lamppost on that journey. And I am one of those as well."

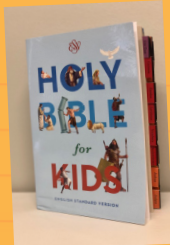
"But the kids need many lampposts along their life, and you could just be a part of what God is gonna do."
