





We would like to highlight Weekday teacher, Jennifer Tomasik. She is assisted by Nikki Clayton. Jennifer has been with Weekday for over three years and Nikki has been with Weekday for almost two years. They are a part of our fifth grade pilot this school year.

We talked to Jennifer, getting her perspective on the ministry...

"A great experience that I remember is with a student here at the school I work at. He was present the entire year, participating each class. At the very end of the year we were saying goodbye, walking back to school, and he asked me a question. He asked, "So wait a second. Jesus is the son of God?" And I said, "Yes, He is!" Jennifer went on saying, "We all laughed because it was the last day, but he got it!"

"I would say the most rewarding thing about being a weekday teacher is the fact that I get to have a full circle moment and give back to my community, because I was a weekday kid," says Jennifer.

What is your advice for someone thinking about becoming a Weekday teacher? Here's what Jennifer said...

"We are the lights on the path of these kids' journeys to God. I want you to think of yourself as a lamppost on that journey. And I am one of those as well."


