Planting:
11. Drought Resilient Planting (Dry Gardens)

Implement dry gardens to conserve water, reduce maintenance needs, enhance aesthetic diversity, and support local biodiversity.

Key Considerations:

- Maintenance:** Diversity of plant species may lead to more complex maintenance regimes.
- Access:** Consider educational signage or guides about drought resilient planting for residents.
- Cost:** Change of use to wine can lead to high implementation costs.
- Plant Selection:** Choose plants that thrive in dry conditions (see supporting research).

Key Benefits Summary:

- Water Conservation:** Reduces the need for frequent watering, conserving water resources.
- Sustainability:** Supports the growth of plants suited to drier conditions, reducing maintenance.
- Aesthetic Diversity:** Offers a variety of visually appealing, drought-tolerant plants.
- Biodiversity Support:** Attracts and sustains local wildlife adapted to drier environments.

Implementation Overview:

- Ensure good drainage and consider adding gravel or sand to improve soil structure.
- Develop planting schemes with a mix of drought-tolerant perennials, shrubs, and grasses. Consider relevant nature-friendly options at all times.
- Plant small specimens to get used to growing environment gradually as they develop.
- Monitor mulching to conserve soil moisture and reduce weed growth.
- Consider signage to illustrate the purpose of the planting.

Consider Combining With:

- Nature Friendly Draining
- Drought Resilient Planting
- Zero Herbicides/Pesticides
- Mulching Planted Beds
- Nature Friendly Planting

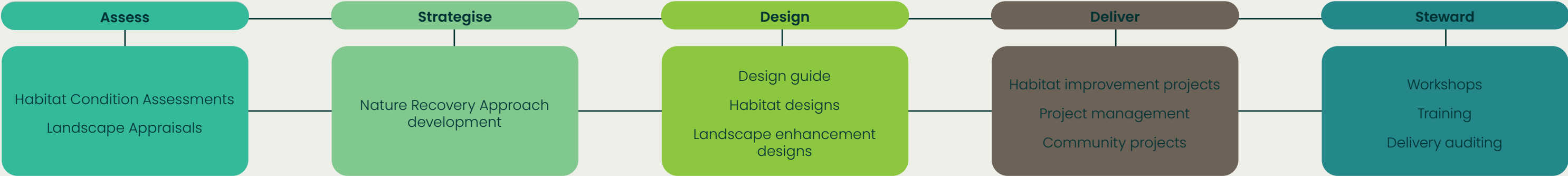
