This leaflet has been produced by local Fulham residents who believe the Clean Air Neighbourhoods are a positive initiative to tackle the climate crisis, air pollution and road safety.

Cleaner, Quieter, Safer Streets Support them or lose them

In the last 12 months the transformation has been truly astonishing:

- 15,000 fewer cars per day (reduction of over 50% in South Fulham*) resulting in:
 - 2 tonnes less Carbon (CO2) across all of South Fulham* (you would need to grow 100 trees a year to capture this)
 - Reduction of 1.35kg of deadly nitrogen oxide (NO2)*
- Safer, calmer, quieter streets to walk and cycle
- Renewed sense of community and connection across all generations
- Higher footfall on the high street (+54% on WBR, +28% NKRd**)
- More high street businesses opening than closing
- Wandsworth Bridge Road has also seen a reduction of traffic (5% northbound 17% southbound*)
 & runs more smoothly due to fewer vehicles entering WBR by using rat-runs (see graphic below)
- Faster bus and travel times on main roads


