### I. COMPETITION OVERVIEW

Mayblades will be conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations of U.S. Figure Skating, as set forth in the current rulebook, and/or current Compete USA handbook as well as any pertinent updates that have been posted on the U.S. Figure Skating website. The short program elements will be skated for the 2023-2024 season.

This competition is open to all eligible, restricted, reinstated or readmitted persons as defined by the Eligibility Rules.

Skaters must be a currently registered member of a U.S. Figure Skating member club, Learn to Skate USA member, a collegiate club or who is an individual member in accordance with the current rulebook. For non-U.S. citizens, please refer to the rulebook for more information.

<u>COVID-19 INFORMATION</u>: For the most recent U.S. Figure Skating COVID-19 policy requirements, CLICK HERE. Lakewood Winter club and Sprinker Recreation center will follow all local and state laws, or policies set by U.S. Figure Skating.

### **EXCEL:**

Mayblades 2024 will have Excel but will not be part of the Excel Series. Excel levels, Beginner – Senior.

- Excel Free Skate Events to be judged IJS: All Excel "PLUS" levels (Preliminary Plus, Pre-Juvenile Plus, Juvenile Plus, Intermediate Plus), and Pre-Juvenile through Senior levels.
- Excel Free Skate Events to be judged 6.0:Pre-Preliminary, Preliminary.

### II. ELIGIBILITY

### **TEST LEVEL**:

As of December 1, 2022, singles athletes may opt to accelerate their test progression within U.S. Figure Skating and thus compete at level(s) best suited for their technical skillset. Athletes must still meet the minimum requirements for each level and additionally, if participating within the National Qualifying Series (NQS) or National Excel Series (Excel), they will establish a **competitive floor** (i.e., the lowest level they can compete at).

The <u>competitive floor</u> is determined only by the level selected through the EMS Series Application for NQS or Excel and is not uniquely tied to competition registration (regardless of series participation).

Example, if an athlete passed their Junior Free Skate test in November and competed in the 2022-23 NQS as a Novice from July - September, they may register for either Novice or Junior in Excel or well-balanced events. The Novice level will remain their competitive floor until they complete an EMS Series Application at the Junior level or higher for NQS or Excel.

Example #2, if an athlete passed their Juvenile Free Skate but has not competed in NQS or Excel (i.e., they have not established a competitive floor), they have the option to compete Pre-Preliminary – Intermediate (if skate up is permitted). While the options are wide, U.S. Figure Skating entrusts the coach to guide the athlete to the select the appropriate level for the athlete based on their technical skillset.

## Eligibility Notes:

- 1. The singles free skate test levels will remain as a minimum requirement to compete.
- 2. Athletes may not skate down in any event.
- 3. This update does NOT apply to Adult, Showcase and Solo Dance.

### **SKATESAFE COMPLIANCE:**

### **COACHES**

To be an eligible coach at a non-qualifying competition, coaches must meet the applicable compliance requirements and verified by U.S. Figure Skating. Coach compliance falls into three categories, Coach/Choreographer, Learn to Skate USA Instructor, or Foreign Coach/Choreographer. Details regarding compliance requirements can be found <u>HERE</u>. All compliance requirements must be met at the time of check-in to access the competition, no exceptions.

With Entryeeze, coaches must be included within a skater/team's registration or updated through their Entryeeze Skater Portal via "My Coaches" or "Team Personnel." All coaches declared at the time of registration will be included on the registration confirmation email. Note: There is no registration approval process within Entryeeze as the data (membership and test level) is tied to the U.S. Figure Skating database. Non-compliant coaches will receive automated email reminders through the start of the competition.

### **MANDATORY ATHLETES**

Athletes age 18+ as of the competition start date who will be competing on a team (i.e., synchro, ice dance, pairs, shadow dance, theatre, etc.) with at least one Minor Athlete must complete SafeSport<sup>TM</sup> Training. \*

Minor athletes who turn 18 mid-season are encouraged to seek parental consent to take the online SafeSport<sup>TM</sup> Training early to avoid any disruptions in their ability to participate as the training is required upon turning 18. The athlete will not be SkateSafe compliant until they have completed the training and their Members Only portal reflects completion. Please email <u>skatesafe@usfigureskating.org</u> for instructions or questions regarding parental consent.

### **III. REGISTRATION INFORMATION**

Registration will open on **Friday, March 10th** at **2:00 pm PT** (if events begin earlier, registration will open earlier). Please check the LWC Website <u>Mayblades 2024</u> for details. The registration desk will be open one hour prior to, and during the competition.

Please register/check-in promptly upon arrival. Skaters must register at least one hour prior to their first event. Please be sure to select the correct event and confirm your entry with your coach prior to submitting your entry.

The LOC and Chief Referee reserve the right to combine events.

\*\*\*You will be asked the following "survey" question during registration: "If you are the only skater in any of the events you entered, would you prefer to skate anyway, or withdraw from the single skater event with a refund." Your response to this question is final and will help us process the schedule quicker.

Entry fees do not include practice ice. Practice ice is purchased separately. Online registrations will be accepted via Entryeeze. Payment must be made at the time of registration by credit card only. Each transaction includes a 3% transaction fee.

Late entries and changes to your entry after this date will be accepted at the discretion of the Chief Referee and will be assessed a \$30.00 fee

### **Registration Deadline:**

### April 21, 2024 at 11:59 PM ET/8:59 PM PT

Late entries will be accepted only at the discretion of the chief referee, and a late fee of \$30.00 will be charged. This includes entry fees, content forms and event changes made after April 21, 2024 11:59 PM ET/8:59 PM PT.

\* The Music and PPC deadline is **May 3, 2024 11:59 PM ET/8:59 PM PT**. Any music or PPC that has not been received by May 3, will receive an automatic late fee of \$30 per missing item. All late fees must be paid prior to registration.

#### **PARTNERED EVENTS:**

Only one partner will complete registration for the team. During the registration process, you will be asked to identify your partner and verify their test information. The registered partner will be responsible for managing all aspects of the competition for the team including music/PPC upload, practice ice sales, etc.

### **FOREIGN SKATERS:**

Non-U.S. skaters intending to register for this competition must set up a non-member account prior to registering for the competition (<u>click here for HOW TO</u>). This can be done by choosing the "Non-Member? Create Account" option on the <u>Members Only</u> login page.

## **TEST CREDIT:**

Skaters requesting test credit must select the option "Test Credit" during registration or contact the LOC to add through the "Add Event" process within Entryeeze. The LOC will go to the skater profile and request the test credit (after the close of registration) and add this to the skater account. Skaters will be able to pay for any added event by admin, by logging into the Members Only, where they will have a notification to click and pay. Skaters can pick up their completed test credit packet from the Registration/Check-in desk approximately one hour after the event concludes. Test Credit packets are \$15 and only available for Juvenile through Senior well-balanced and Excel free skates.

### **MUSIC SUBMISSION/UPLOAD:**

Entryeeze MUSIC UPLOAD: Competitors participating in events with music are required to upload their music to the Entryeeze Portal no later than May 3, 2024 at 11:59 PM ET/8:59 PM PT. After this date, skaters will be locked out of this feature and subject to a \$30 late fee.

The late fee will automatically be added to each skater's cart who doesn't meet this requirement by the deadline. Late fees will not be removed under any circumstances and must be paid prior to receiving the skater credential onsite.

Competitors must also have available a backup copy of their competition music on a cell phone and it must be immediately available rink-side whenever the skater competes. If the phone does not have the standard round headset connector, an appropriate adapter, such as an Apple Lightning connector or Samsung USB-C adapter is required to be attached. The phone should be presented to the music person with the file ready to play, phone in airplane mode and volume turned to maximum.

## PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT (PPC) SUBMISSION/UPLOAD – FOR IJS EVENTS ONLY:

Entryeeze PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT (PPC) – Competitors participating in IJS events are required to submit PPC in the Entryeeze Competition Portal no later than May 3, 2024, at 11:59 PM ET/8:59 PM PT. After this date, skaters will be locked out of this feature in Entryeeze and subject to a \$30 late fee. The late fee will automatically be added to each skater's cart who doesn't meet this requirement by the deadline. Late fees will not be removed under any circumstances and must be paid prior to receiving the skater credential onsite.

Entry fees will not be refunded after entry deadline, May 3, 2024, 11:59 PM ET/8:59 PM PT unless no competition exists or the event is canceled. There will be no refunds for medical withdrawals.

### **IV. COMPETITION DETAILS**

### **FACILITIES**:

The competition will be held at **Sprinker Recreation Center**, located at **14824** C **Street South, Tacoma, Washington 98444**. You may contact the arena by calling **253-798-4000**. The ice dimensions of the rink are **85'X200'**. There are coin operated lockers for smaller personal items. The upstairs viewing area is a comfortable temperature for viewers.

## **LOCKER ROOMS AND CHANGING AREAS:**

There are NO dressing rooms available for skaters to use, please come prepared and ready to compete.

Athletes will be provided with an area to put skates on but changing will not be permitted in these spaces.

## **U.S. Figure Skating Travel Policy:**

All travel must strictly adhere to Two-Deep Leadership requirements. An Adult Participant cannot transport a Minor Athlete one-on-one and Two-Deep Leadership requirements must be adhered to at all times during In-Program travel, by transporting at least two minors or a second Adult Participant. An Adult Participant cannot share a hotel room or other sleeping arrangement with a Minor Athlete(s). Full details of the SkateSafe Travel Policy and any exceptions can be found starting on page 12 of the SkateSafe Handbook.

### **OFFICIAL WEBSITE & UPDATES:**

Official notices will be emailed to competitors through Entryeeze and posted to the LWC website, Lakewood Winter Club. It is the responsibility of each competitor, parent, and coach to read the messages for any schedule changes and/or additional information. Skaters are expected to arrive 45- minutes prior to the scheduled time of their event. A tentative schedule of events will be posted prior to the competition. It is the responsibility of each competitor, parent and coach to check the schedule online frequently for any schedule changes and/or additional information pertaining to the competition.

### **SCHEDULE**

Competitors may be scheduled on any day or time during the announced dates of the competition. The competition and practice ice schedule will be available after the close of entries. All participants will be notified via email once available.

### **PRACTICE ICE:**

Practice ice is NOT included with your registration. Practice ice sessions will be 20 minutes. A

maximum of 2 practice ice sessions may be requested per skater. Compete USA (Basic Skills) practice ice is 20 minutes and **no** music will be played.

## **AWARDS:**

Awards will be presented for first through sixth place in the Rainier Room upstairs immediately following the official posting of each event.

#### **SPECIAL AWARD:**

The Al & Iria Beeler Artistic Award – Al and Iria were the driving force that kept the Lakewood Winter Club and the Lakewood Ice Arena together from 1960-1982. They started going to the ice arena in 1953 when their daughter, Marianne, started skating. Iria started working at the rink as a bookkeeper in 1954 and became the manager in 1968, a job she held until the rink closed in 1982. Al became very active in the club and was president for eight years. He also held other offices such as treasurer and test chairman, and he served on the Board of Directors for more than 25 years. He became interested in judging and earned his Gold judge credentials. He was also very involved in the annual ice shows and spent countless hours building

props. He worked tirelessly when the LWC hosted the 1987 U.S. Figure Skating Championships in Tacoma. When the Lakewood Ice Arena collapsed in 1982, Al worked hard to forge a relationship with Pierce County Parks & Recreation Department, allowing the LWC to transfer its operation to Sprinker Recreation Center. In their honor, the Lakewood Winter Club will present this award to a skater from the Intermediate through Senior Level, who the artistic judges feel presented the most artistic Free Skate performance.

#### **VOLUNTEER COMPLIANCE:**

Reminder: Compliant positions at all U.S. Figure Skating events include key LOC members, locker room monitors and <u>ALL</u> medical event personnel. <u>Click here for volunteer compliance</u> information.

### **PHOTO/VIDEO**:

Video will be provided to all competitors and is included in the entry fees. Competitors will pick up their video following the event from the professional videographer. Any other professional videography is prohibited. All other videotaping and photography is restricted to hand-held battery operated equipment, without tripod, and is permissible only in the upper viewing area. No videotaping or photography from rink side. Please be courteous to those viewing the event. Solicitation by any photographer or agent of anyone to be the subject of still or video photography is not permitted. For safety reasons, **no flash photography is allowed during the event.** Note, per U.S. Figure Skating policy, photographing and/or recording of anyone other than your own skater is strictly prohibited. Please refer to the Basic Ice Usage and Skater Etiquette Information document found in the Club Resource section of Member's Only.
