

## ICE MACHINE CLEANER

ICE MACHINE CLEANER is a liquid solution of phosphoric acid formulated for the removal of hardness scale, and organic build ups within ice machines. Directions: For ice machines, leave pump in operation but turn off refrigeration.

Directions: For ice machines, leave pump in operation but turn off refrigeration.

- 1. Drain unit and refill with fresh water.
- 2. Add Ice Machine Cleaner to water in unit. Use about 8 fluid ounces for each 3 gallons of water.
- 3. Allow cleaner to circulate for about 30 minutes. If solution does not contact all scaled surfaces, use a brush to get cleaning solution to those parts. If scale is extra heavy, another dose of cleaner may be necessary. Ice machine drums may be cleaned by adding one cup of cleaner to a glass or plastic container holding 2 quarts of water and brushing the solution on the scaled surfaces.
- 4. After scale has been removed, drain out all water and flush thoroughly with fresh water
- 5. Rinse out product container and dispose of properly.
- 6. Return machine to service; discard first batch of ice. First Aid:

If poisoning occurs contact a doctor of poisons information centre. PH 13 1126. If swallowed do not induce vomiting, give milk or water and seek medical advice. If skin contact does occur remove contaminated clothing and wash thoroughly with water. For eye contact, irrigate with water for 15 minutes and if irritation persists seek medical advice.
