

SCUM LINE CLEANER

Swimming pools accumulate body oils, hair products, conditioners, makeup, hand lotions, sunscreens, and other residues from swimmers. These substances float on the surface and cling to the pool's waterline, forming a "scum line."

Scum Line Cleaner effectively removes these unsightly and unsanitary scum lines. When used as directed, it does not disrupt the pool's chemical balance or pose health risks to swimmers. The cleaner dissolves the scum, which is then carried through the skimmer to the filter. The chlorine or bromine in the pool can then address any remaining residues, ensuring a clean and appealing pool.

Instructions:

- 1. Apply Scum Line Cleaner using a sponge or mop.
- 2. Allow up to 5 minutes for the cleaner to react with the scum.
- 3. Use the application tools to agitate and loosen the scum.
- 4. Rinse the area with water.
- 5. Minimize the amount of scum and cleaner that enters the pool. Rinse mops, sponges, and other tools in a bucket, not directly into the pool, to reduce the load on the filtration system.
