

Measure the Temple

Rev. 11:1 And there was given me a reed like unto a rod: and the angel stood, saying, Rise, and measure the temple of God, and the altar, and them that worship therein. *

2 But the court which is without the temple leave out, and measure it not; for it is given unto the Gentiles: and the holy city shall they tread under foot forty and two months. *

When we speak of measuring a subject in the Bible, I look to see how many times it's mentioned in the different books of the Bible. *

In the case of the Tabernacle, it measures out in the Old Testament to be 280. *

In the books of Exodus, Leviticus, and Numbers, it measures out to be 218 times. *

In the New Testament, it measures out to be 30 times. *

In the book of Hebrews 9 times and in Rev. 3 times. *

We also want to include the Temple, which is measured at 183 times.

The other interesting names for God place of dwelling. *

The Secret Place. The Holy of Holies, and The Most Holy. *
