Adapting Animals Desert vs. Arctic

Polar Bear - Arctic

- 1. Black skin helps to absorb any heat
- 2. Its hairs are actually hollow tubes because it helps to "suck" the heat down to the black skin
- 3. Small ears because if they were bigger they would freeze
- 4. Rough pads on its feet that helps it to not slip on ice

Rattlesnake – Desert

- Doesn't urinate which helps it not get too dehydrated
- Its overlapping scales are made of keratin which helps it retain water
- Tan skin patterns help so it can camouflage and hide from predators
- Great sense of smell helps it detect water from miles away
