

## FOREST ANIMAL DIETS

**Bald Eagle**: small sea birds, reptiles like snakes, squirrels, trout, salmon, rabbits, raccoons, muskrats, beavers, deer, ducks, crabs, weasels, carrion

Cougar/Mountain Lion: porcupines, deer, beavers, elk, fish, rodents, goats, hedgehog, carrion

**Owl**: squirrels (their most common prey), wood rats, mice, voles, rabbits, bats, small birds, snakes, lizards, skunks, shrews, weasels

**Bear**: fruits, berries, nuts, ants, wasps, crayfish, frogs, birds' eggs, mice and small rodents, squirrels, woodchucks, rabbits, acorns, hickory nuts, beechnuts, hazelnuts, pine nuts, leaves, grass, deer scat, fish like salmon, young deer and sheep, insects, worms

Beaver: Tree barks, twigs, leaves, water plants

Minnow: any kind of river plants

**Frogs**: insects, worms, snails, newts. Some species eat small fish. Larger frog species eat small reptiles and mammals, like mice and lizards.

Newts: insects, worms and slugs, shrimp, water lice, insect larvae, water snails, frog tadpoles, algae

**Trout**: Aquatic insects and their larvae (nymphs), smaller fish like minnows, trout, eels, crayfish, shrimp, tadpoles, frogs, worms, fish eggs, snails, mice and baby birds that fall into the water

**Salmon**: other aquatic animals, like tadpoles, squid, other fish

Cardinals: insects, seeds, tree sap

**Copperhead Snake**: small mammals like mice, voles, squirrels, large insects, frogs, and other snakes, mice, small birds, frogs

Quail: a variety of grains, leaves, small insects, grass, legumes, insects, acorns

Burying Beetle: only carrion of: insects, mice, voles, opossums, birds, snakes

**Lizards**: insects, plants – anything smaller than it is

Raccoon: muskrat, frogs, fish, amphibians, insects, eggs, mice, vole, berries, nuts

**Fox**: muskrat, mollusks, insects, crayfish and earthworms, rabbits, voles, mice, eggs, birds, reptiles, amphibians, fish, deer fawns, shrews

**Muskrat**: water plants and small shellfish, cattails, sedges, rushes, water lilies, pondweeds, wild rice, pickerelweed, clover, willow, acorns, mussels, crayfish, frogs, snails, fish

**Hedgehog**: insects of many kinds like beetles, caterpillars, earthworms, snails, frogs, snakes, bird eggs, mushrooms, grass, berries

Nightingale: insects and larvae and fruit

**Coyote**: porcupines, squirrels, voles, prairie dogs, eastern cottontails, ground squirrels and mice, small birds, snakes, lizards, deer, cattle, small insects.

Bobcats: porcupines, rabbits, squirrels, birds, fish, insects, foxes, skunks
