To Parents of Fourth Grade Students:

Supply requests for each grade level were posted on the Lincoln website. Each teacher has provided a more specific list adapted closely to classroom needs. Please use this updated list to determine if your child has all the requested supplies. All contributions are considered voluntary donations. As always, the school will provide the necessary supplies when families do not.

Must Haves:

- Backpack or school bag to carry books, notebooks, etc.
- 2 inch, 3 ring binder with at least 5 dividers (**NO pocket folders**)
- Pencil pouch that clips into binder and/or pencil box that fastens tightly shut
- Mechanical pencils are NOT permitted
- Colored pencils (NOT crayons crayons are not used in the classroom)
- 3 highlighters (1 yellow, 1 pink, 1 green)
- Ruler with Standard and Metric scales
- Eraser (Magic Rub type of eraser works the best)
- Protractor <u>please wait until the spring so</u>

- 1 pair of ear buds or headphones that remains at school
- 2 or more black pens (erasable ones are awesome)
- White Out tape

- Ream of copying paper (2nd most important)
- Box of tissues

- Fine or extra fine black felt pens
- Fine or extra fine black Sharpie pens
- Zip Lock bags (gallon, quart, or sandwich)
