- (1) pair of wired earbuds or headphones (in a labeled bag, no Bluetooth)
- Colored Pencils (12 or 24 pack)
- Packages of Post It Notes (3" x 3" size) in pastel/pale colors.

- Fine point permanent markers like Sharpie pens
- White out tape
- Highlighters
- Fine point black or colored Flair pens
- Erasable pens (black or blue ink)
