BOOK CLUBS



FYI: we will typically meet on Fridays.

This week is weird because last week was so short week. So, TODAY we will have the book club meeting for the **first chunk**.

You will turn this in on Tuesday and it will go home graded on Wednesday.

This week we will be reading Chunk 2 for our book clubs. Time will be provided every day to read and write jot dots. However, if you're not done with the day's reading/jot dots, it DOES become homework and must be completed before the next day. I understand we all have busy schedules so a little wiggle room is okay. For example, if you have a dance class on Mondays, try to do as much in class as possible. And then try to catch up on Tuesday. Make sense?

FYI, the jot dots are not supposed to be a lot of writing. Each one should be just enough words to know the point. We only write a lot on the Top 4 post-its. Usually done on Thursdays. Everyone has a book club calendar that says what to read each day. I will also let each book club know how many jot dots I expect per chapter.

Now that we are on different books, keep in mind I am NOT reading them out loud to the class. So, please consider still reading the book your child is reading so you can have valuable "book talks." It's actually more important now than before. Thank you!

PLEASE NOTE:

On normal weeks, we read our chunk Monday through Wednesday and write jot dots. On Thursday we work with our club on the Top 4 post-its. On Friday mornings we have our actual book club meeting.
