We are continuing to meet every Friday with our book clubs.

Since we are reading different

books, don't forget to write the daily reading in your agenda for the week's chunk. This is written in your Book Contract calendar. This should be in your reading binder.

#### REMEMBER:

- 1. There is "wiggle room" with the daily reading. The important part is to have it finished ideally by Wednesday night. If you need time on Thursday to read that is okay but you can't decide Top 4 together if you haven't finished reading the chunk.
- 2. It is important NOT to read ahead!!
- 3. For each chapter, write one or two events that you think might be important.
- 4. On Thursday, discuss with your book club and decide the Top 4. Then write the 4 post-its.
- 5. Each book club will meet on Friday for their Book Club discussion.
- 6. Make sure to get your reading log signed by next Monday evening. (They will show signatures on Tuesday morning.)
