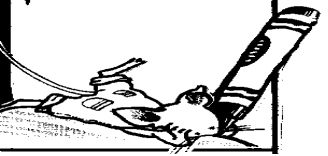

Reading Log

Last week we focused on a new way to do our Reading Log.

While reading, we made jot dots of events that we believed to be important.

At the end of the week we decided our Top 4 events. Then everyone chose two of those to write about on the Reading Log.

This is going home on Monday and needs to come back on Tuesday with a parent signature.

We will do the same thing this week as we get used to the new way.

REMINDER:

For the rest of the year, we will be writing WHY these events are so important. Our writing needs to show deep thinking and we need to support our ideas with evidence from the text.

Some of the common mistakes are:

1. Writing mostly the plot/what happens.
2. Not writing ENOUGH to support your idea.
3. Not choosing an event that is **most important**.

For example, last week we read about Rontu winning his battle with the other dogs. Can you understand why this was important? She now feels safe from all the wild dogs because they respect Rontu and won't attack him or who he protects ever again.

We will continue to practice this TOGETHER and I show how to choose the Top 4 most important events each week.
