(This replaces what used to be a place for students to track their reading strategies.) Instead, parents will see teacher comments based on the weekly reading "check

in." You will also see an overall assessment for each check-in. FYI:

- $\sqrt{+}$ = very good (like an A-/B+) $\sqrt{-}$ = grade level (like a B)
- $\sqrt{-}$ = concerning (like a C)
- = high alert (like a F)

This should help parents stay more connected to the process each week.
