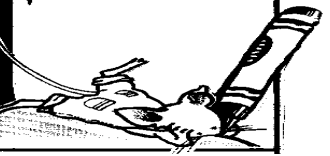

because we will be hunting for them this week and next week.



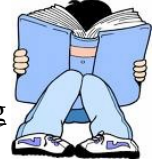
