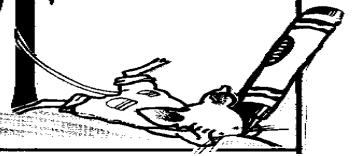

Book Clubs

The "Final Thoughts" test is on Friday!



We will be spending a lot of time in class, preparing together. The students will meet with their book clubs to collaborate, and they will also be getting feedback from me. There is a test support link called Book Club Tests. Since we have different books, some of the examples cannot be as specific as they were for earlier books. However, the test will follow the same format that was used for the last book club test and also for the How to Steal a Dog test. There will be FOUR parts so check out the link!

Also, **each night there will be study evidence written in everyone's agenda. Students need to show up at school with the evidence and their parent**

signature. The parent signature verifies that you studied for at least 30 minutes. It will be very helpful for mom or dad to quiz your child each night to make sure they know the information. The quizzing only needs to be verbal, not written. If you have read the book with your child, you will find it easier to see if their answers are on track. Another help is to check out the reading log entries. I write comments each week that help guide thinking and spark examples and ideas about theme and character growth.
