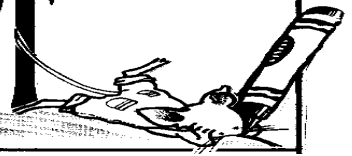

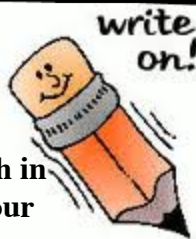

Book Clubs



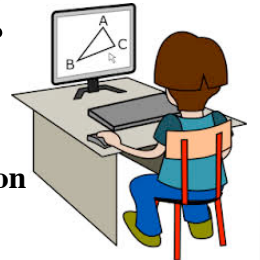
It's been a week of vacation!

CAASPP Test



We will be taking the CAASPP test NEXT WEEK on Monday through Wednesday in the mornings.

FYI, the test is untimed; however, most students will be finished each day by 11:00. Your child will be given extra supervised time if needed in another setting (not room 10).

Everyone needs to have their earphones at school. Sometimes they accidentally get left at home so please make sure they are at school or in your backpack.
