Thanks for Donations

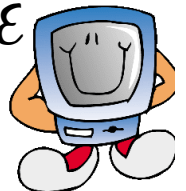

Check Blue Folders & Agenda DAILY



The "Blue Folder" is our #1 daily communication tool. Please note that graded papers go home in this folder. If your child has a grade of 1 on a paper it should be in the Blue Folder. This assignment needs to be signed and returned the next day. (If this happens, a quick note should be in the agenda and this also needs a signature.) You will see that inside the left pocket is for things going to school, the right side is for things going home. Papers that go home in the MESH folder is Lincoln information. If it is from me, it will be in the Blue Folder. FYI, The MESH folder should be returned empty on Thursday. I do NOT always send the MESH folder home each week.

Please also check your child's Lincoln Agenda every school day. We will use it to write daily assignments. We will also write other events and information that is important to be aware of each week. This will include events happening at school that week and also reminders etc. Sometimes a parent signature will be requested. Let's get in the habit to check both daily.
