Also, you can help by making sure those post-its are consistently put into their agenda and not left at home accidentally. These words become a personal word bank that we use at school for Word Power. **I'm expecting 16 new words by Thursday** (since there is no school on Friday).



### IMPORTANT:

**Please do NOT use a dictionary to find words.** Also, do not choose words used for things like science, math, or social studies (like circuit, nonrenewable resources, toyon bush or botanical.) Also stay away from nouns (like Mt. Whitney or pamphlet). The idea is to choose words that are used daily.
