Practical Tool of the Month: The 'One Thing' Rule

Before every service, ask your team:

'What is the ONE thing we want every child to walk away with today?'

Examples:

- God hears me.
- Jesus is my helper.
- I can worship anywhere.
- The Bible is true.

This rule creates clarity, unity, and intentionality. It also helps parents reinforce the lesson at home.

Creative Idea: The 'Light It Up' Challenge

Encourage kids to 'shine bright' all week by doing one act of kindness each day.

Provide a simple card with seven boxes they can check off.

Next Sunday, celebrate every child who completed the challenge.

Small habits create big disciples.

Leader Growth Corner: Don't Lose Your Wonder

Children learn best from leaders who still have wonder in their voice.

Ask God this month to refresh your imagination, your joy, and your sense of awe.

Kids don't need perfect leaders - they need alive ones.
