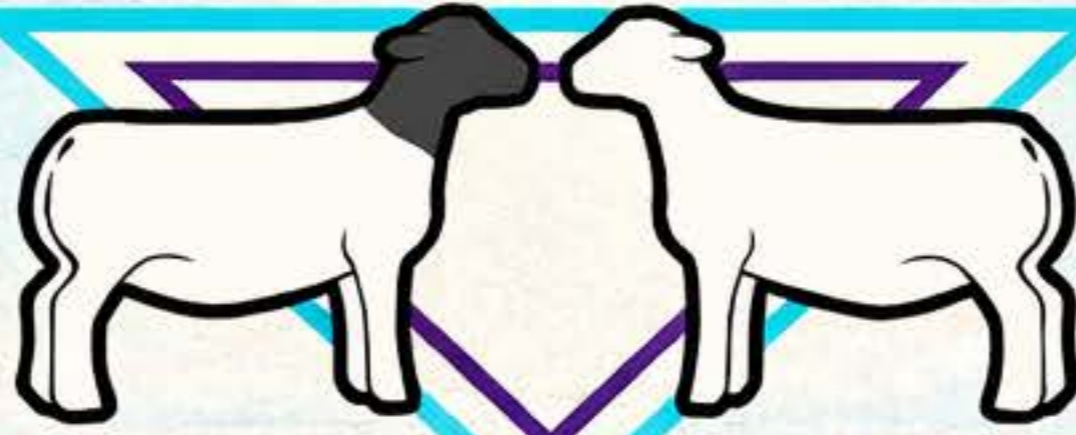

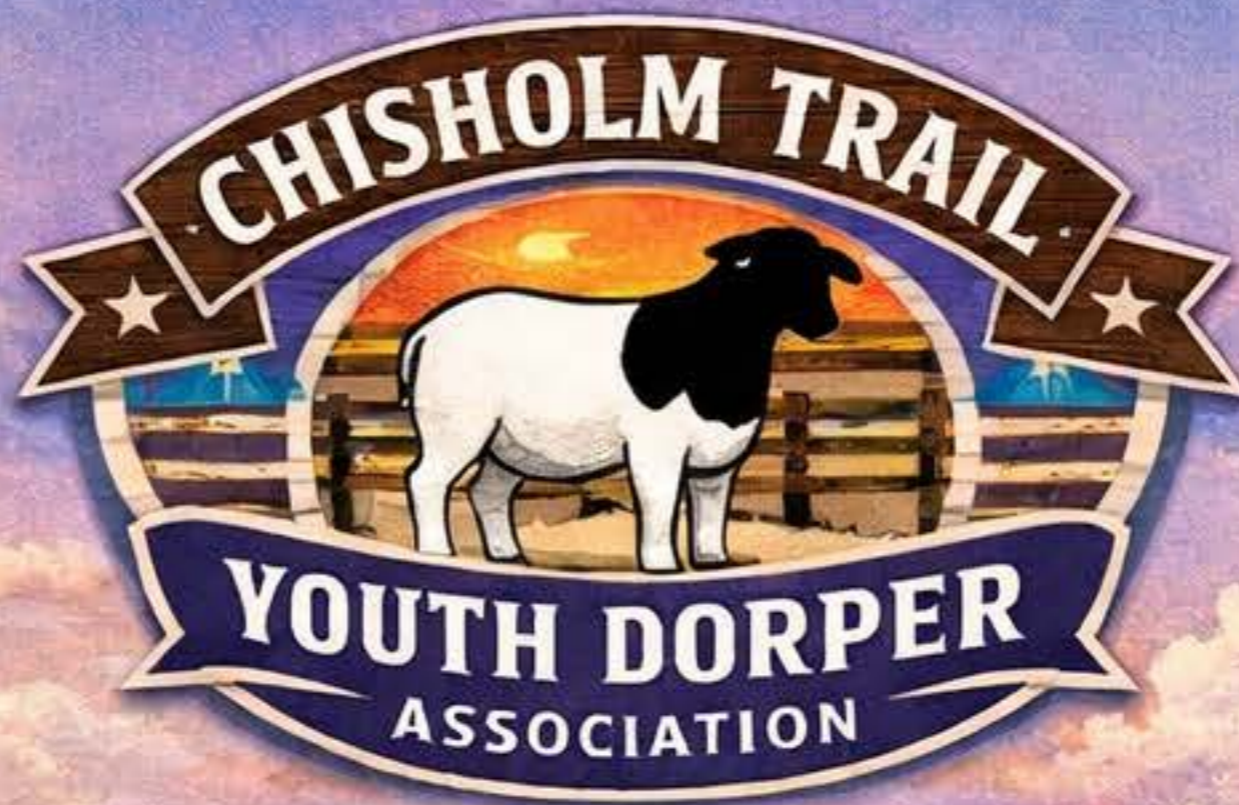

Saturday, May 30th 1pm

Dorper Rams, Dorper Ewes, White Dorper Rams, White Dorper Ewes

Rams

- Spring Ram Lamb (1/1/26 - 4/30/26)
- Fall Ram Lamb (9/1/25 - 12/31/25)
- Yearling Ram (9/1/24 - 8/31/25)
- Aged Ram (born on or before 8/31/24)

Ewes

- Spring Ewe Lamb (3/1/26 - 4/30/26)
- Winter Ewe Lamb (1/1/26 - 2/28/26)
- Late Fall Ewe Lamb (11/1/25 - 12/31/25)
- Early Fall Ewe Lamb (9/1/25 - 10/31/25)
- Yearling Ewe (9/1/24 - 8/31/25)
- Aged Ewe (born on or before 8/31/24)



Group Classes

Pair of Rams, Pair of Ewes, Pair of Sheep, Flock (1 ram & 4 ewes)

Supreme Ram & Ewe

- Same classes for Dorpers and White Dorpers.
- If there are more than 5 entries in the spring ewe class and the sheep are split between March and April we can split the class.
- If there are more than 3 rams in the spring ram class and split between Jan/Feb & Mar/Apr we will split the class.
- Yearling ewe class will be split if more than 15 in the class.
- Premier Exhibitor will be awarded based on points earned in classes 1st-5, 2nd-4, 3rd-3, 4th-2, 5th-1. Group and Champion classes will not count.
- Exhibitor must be a CTYDA member in good standing (dues paid for 2026)
- There is no minimum age for exhibitors, however the exhibitor must show their animal by controlling their head. Another junior exhibitor may assist in the ring as the healer, however they must also be entered in the show.
- Sheep must be owned by the youth exhibitor. Partnerships are only allowed if both owners are youth and members.

- Supreme Ram/Ewe - Banners
- Champions/Reserves - Buckles & Banners
- Placings - Ribbons

Bred & Owned Breeding Sheep Show

Saturday, May 30th - 30 minutes after breeding show

Rams

Toddler - any ram born in 2026

Junior - any ram born in 2025

Intermediate - any ram born in 2024

Senior - any ram born 2023 and earlier



Ewes

Toddler - any ram born in 2026

Junior - any ewe born in 2025

Intermediate - any ewe born in 2024

Senior - any ewe 2023 and earlier

Supreme Ram & Ewe

- Same classes for Dorpers & White Dorpers
 - Bred & Owned sheep must be in the youth's name be listed as the breeder and owner. Partnerships are NOT allowed.
 - Exhibitor must be a CTYDA member in good standing.
 - There is no minimum age for exhibitors, however the exhibitor must show their animal by controlling the head. Another junior exhibitor may assist in the ring as the healer, however they must also be entered in the show.
 - Service type on the registraton paperwork must be Natural Insemination or AI, however the sheep must still meet the requirements in rule #2 where the youth exhibitor is listed as the breeder and owner.

Production Class

Record Books Due: 5/23, On-Line Interviews 5/26, Live Show 5/30

The production class is open to all registered sheep. The goal is to showcase production females and their offspring, as applicable to sheep production, along with instilling good record keeping skills, money handling skills and public speaking in youth.

Record books of gains and associated costs to produce each animal will be kept and turned in no later than May 23rd. The production books are done online through google slides. Once entries are received a link to the form will be emailed out. This should be used as a guide, pages may be added if more room is needed.

Interviews will be done prior to the event so that we can ensure the exhibitors receive the attention that the interview deserves. Meetings will be done over teams, and schedule for 5/26.

Final placing and determination of "Champion Producer" will be based off a combined score of the following:

- Live Show Ewe & Lamb (production based) 25%**
- Live Show Ewe & Lamb (placing in age division) 25%**
- Record Book 25%**
- Interview 25%**

Lambs for the production contest must be born in 2026.

Divisions:

Juniors (5 grade and under), Intermediate (6th-8th) & Senior (9th-12th)

FITTING COMPETITION

FRIDAY, MAY 29TH

All divisions will start at the same time and have 1 hour to complete their requirements. Below is the list of the requirements based on the age of the exhibitor. If they want to do more they can. Since all competitors will be clipping at the same time be sure to bring enough equipment so you don't have to share with someone else. If you need something please contact Edie or Zach at least 2 weeks prior to the event so we can make arrangements. If you need to borrow a sheep for this competition let us know 2 weeks in advance.

The sheep for the competition can not have been clipped 6 weeks prior to the event.

Sheep can not have been clipped since 4/18/26

JUNIOR

AGE 11 AND UNDER

SHEEP CAN BE WASHED AND BLOWN DRY PRIOR TO THE START OF THE COMPETITION
HOOVES CAN BE TRIMMED

EXHIBITOR WILL BE EXPECTED TO CLIP THE BODY OF THE SHEEP UP THE BASE OF THE
NECK

INTERMEDIATE

AGE 12-14

SHEEP CAN BE WASHED, HOWEVER MUST BE SOAKING WET PRIOR TO THE START OF THE
COMPETITION

HOOVES CAN BE TRIMMED

EXHIBITOR WILL BE EXPECTED TO CLIP THE BODY OF THE SHEEP AND THE NECK, BUT
NOT THE HEAD. THEY WILL ALSO BE EXPECTED TO BLEND THE LEGS.

SENIOR

AGE 15-18

SHEEP CAN NOT BE WASHED PRIOR TO THE START OF THE COMPETITION.

HOOVES CAN NOT BE TRIMMED

EXHIBITOR WILL BE EXPECTED TO CLIP THE ENTIRE SHEEP.

AWARDS: CHAMPION/RESERVE FOR EACH AGE DIVISION
