After you read through the materials, we can setup a zoom call if you would like more in-depth information.

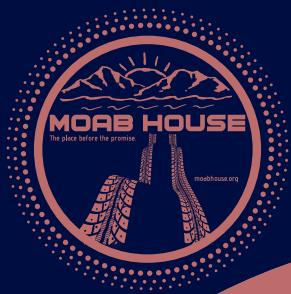

THE PLACE BEFORE THE PROMISE.

THE NEED

In the U.S. 32% of children who reach age 18 in foster care would have waited in the system for over three years and once they were out of the system, 25-50% of these young people will face a living crisis such as couch surfing, doubling up, moving frequently, having trouble paying rent, and facing eviction. 70% of the fatherless would love to go to college, but 1 in 2 of the "forgotten ones" will develop some type of substance abuse.

IT'S NOT THEIR FAULT

OUR STORY

My name is Marcie Consiglio. For 22 years I have worked in Corporate America, managed businesses, and handled the internal operations of those businesses. I have also loved being in direct sales, and began my relationship with a luxury hair-care brand in 2018. Excited that I could finally attend a conference for my business, I took the leap and attended Monatons in September of 2019. Sitting in my seat in the Quicken Arena in Columbus Ohio on September 14, 2019, and feeling the tangible presence of God, He spoke to my heart so clearly. He told me that I would build houses for foster youth. It was in that moment that I felt called to donate 50% of everything I made in Monat to building a house for older youth so that they would have a safe place to go instead of being thrown out at age 18. God didn't just throw this idea in my lap though. On July 2, 2019, just 74 days before the Lord spoke the vision to me, He told me that I was coming into my Moab. (At the time, I thought He was referring to a Jeep Moab lol!) But the Lord went on to say this: "Moab was the place that Moses saw right before they entered the promised land. It was the place where he was able to stand and see where he was, and where he was going. It was a place of hope and wonder. It was a place of excitement and exhilaration. Moses didn't see the promised land because of his lack of faith, but you will."

THE PLACE BEFORE THE PROMISE

SIERRA:

That was it. The Lord began shifting our hearts. Our youngest daughter began prophesying from the backseat of the car, and would tell my husband and I that we were going to adopt a teenager. We blew it off because we had no desire to adopt (or so we thought). I would tell her to be quiet (she was like the clanging cymbal that scripture talks about), but behind my sunglasses tears would fill my eyes. These were tears of fear, tears of joy, and tears for the unknown. What was God doing? Sierra had already entered our lives because she began coming to our youth group with other girls from her group home, but I never said a word about her. So I prayed and told the Lord that if He wanted us to adopt, He would have to put it on my husband's heart to bring it up to me. (I knew he would NEVER do this. Or so I thought.) That same night we arrived at our oldest daughters' soccer game, I was just getting settled in my chair with my blanket because it was starting to get chilly, and my husband looked at me and began telling me that we needed to do something for Sierra. That was it....the tears flowed....I knew this was God.

RIPPING THE RUG OUT

As Sierra began to settle into our family and wanted to be with us permanently, the Lord began teaching us through the story of Moses and the Israelites. It wasn't easy to convince the powers-that-be that Sierra should be able to leave her group home to come live with us permanently. It wasn't until February 2020 that we finally got the green light to move her in. But as quickly as the door opened, it slammed shut even quicker. We were devastated when her county retracted their approval of the new living arrangement, and would not allow her to come live with us because they insisted she finish out the school year in her school. It was a tremendous blow to all of us, especially Sierra. Living in a group home is not easy, and just when she thought she was so close to leaving- she was pulled back. It took time to process the pain of that situation, but in time we remembered that we had to have faith and believe what God had said. We knew that the school year was almost over, and after that- she would be 18 and able to come live with us. But God.

FAITH. IT MOVES MOUNTAINS

BUT GOD!

By mid-March there were rumblings of school closings because of Covid-19, and then it happened. We picked Sierra up from her group home after school as we did everyday, to bring her to our home to stay for the weekend. When we got home, we got the call and were told that her group home had been locked down and none of the girls were come in or go out. We made the decision to keep Sierra at home with us. Not knowing what Covid would turn into- we made the right choice. Sierra's county had no choice but to allow her to stay because of the lockdowns, and God took a situation of pain, and turned it to joy!

IT'S NOT ALWAYS ROSES

THEIR STORY

Sadly. This is not the story for most 18 year olds. The reality for them is that they will turn 18 and still be separated and estranged from their family. They will end up going from couch to couch without much of a direction in life. They won't go to college- not because they don't want to, but because no one is there to help them and encourage them. Do you know what these forgotten ones are missing? LOVE.

PLANT AND HARVEST

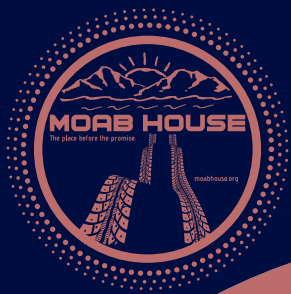
THE SOLUTION

But we have the answer! Praise God! The Lord planted the vision on the inside of me for something better. Moab House will be known as a home that's sole purpose is to love these forgotten ones and help grow them into adulthood in a positive and productive manner. Not only will Moab House provide them housing, food, and access to transportation, but the young adult will have a full-time, live-in mom and dad who will pour into them in a way that a mom and dad should. But Moab House won't stop there. The vision isn't complete until the local church is plugged in. The Lord showed me that the Church's position in Moab House will be to plant houses through their monetary support, and wrap their arms around these young people. This is a local mission where church members will be able to sign up to share their talents and giftings in such areas as gardening, scrapbooking, physical fitness, and finance, just to name a few.- but there is SO MUCH MORE! Imagine spending time with young people in a way that comes naturally to you, but excites them! When we connect with people relationally, we change the dynamic from being strangers to being friends, and then family. And family is hard to leave (even in the worst times) when you love them and spend quality time with them.

Salvation. Knowing Christ. Teaching these "forgotten ones" that they matter, and then watch them spread the gospel to others. It is the essence of why we exist on this earth. Moab House Parents will receive annual income totaling \$66,000. This income represents 3 parts. The first part equals the annual living expenses of \$21,600 which covers rent, utilities, groceries, basic toiletries, and transportation fuel. The second part equaling \$22,800 covers major medical, dental, and vision benefits. The remaining \$21,600 represents the take home pay of the mother who will remain in the home on a full-time basis. The father will be expected to have full time employment outside of the home. This is important for the young people to see.

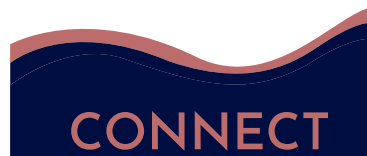
