



As we close out this year, I'm overwhelmed by the quiet but extraordinary transformations happening every day inside Moab House. These moments don't make headlines, but they change the lives of the young adults who call this place home. We have great news by the end of 2025, Moab House will have officially reached full capacity with 8 MYAs. For the first time, our home is completely full, and it's your financial support that has made this possible!

Here are just a few of the moments you helped create:

One MYA began college this fall. Just a few weeks in, she was overwhelmed and ready to quit. But because of supporters like you, she had a stable home to return to, and the presence of caring adults who could sit with her, sometimes for hours. Your support allowed us to listen to her fears, offer encouragement, and give her a safe place to share her struggles and her tears. That time and relationship helped her feel truly seen and heard, and it gave her the confidence to keep going instead of walk away from her future. She is still in school today because you made this level of support possible.

Another MYA was struggling with basic self-care. Her room, her hygiene, and even her daily routines felt overwhelming. But because of generous donors like you, we were able to complete the renovation of the large east-wing bathroom into four private, trauma-free bathrooms earlier this year. For the first time in her life, she was given something she had never experienced before: a bathroom of her own. That simple dignity changed everything. With a space that belonged only to her, she began taking pride in keeping it clean and caring for herself in ways she had never had the chance to before. Your generosity helped restore her confidence, her sense of worth, and her belief that she deserves stability.

And one of our MYAs surprised us in the best way. While Lori and Sati were out of town on a sabbatical, and our volunteers were providing daily support and care for the MYAs, this MYA stepped up cleaning, organizing, and tending to Moab House without hesitation. This moment of maturity didn't happen by accident. It happened because he lives in a place funded by people who believe in him, and surrounded by adults who consistently invest time, patience, and guidance into his daily growth. Your support gave him the stability he needed to rise to the occasion.

These victories may look simple, but they are life-changing. And they happen because people like you believe in our mission.

As we look toward 2026, our focus is on strengthening the home our MYAs rely on every day. Several essential renovation and replacement projects are now critical:

Walk-In Pantry Remodel: This space is currently a shared laundry room for all 8 MYAs and the house-family. Converting it into a walk-in pantry will greatly improve food storage, organization, and daily meal preparation.

East and West Laundry Closet Upgrades: Each resident wing will have its own laundry closet designed to serve the four MYAs living in that wing. Upgrading these spaces will make laundry safer, more functional, and more accessible. It will also allow MYAs to do their laundry close to their rooms instead of carrying their personal items into common areas, reducing congestion and giving them more privacy and independence.

Houseparent Laundry Replacement: As part of these improvements, we will need to purchase Lori and Sati a new all-in-one washer/dryer unit that will support their daily care of our MYAs, help maintain the home more efficiently, and will afford our houseparents with greater privacy by doing laundry in their apartment.

West Hallway Bathroom Renovation, which must begin and be completed in 2026

A full HVAC system overhaul: Our current system is over 30 years old and is at the end of its life.

These aren't cosmetic improvements they are necessary to maintain a safe, healthy, and stable living environment for every MYA who calls Moab House home.
