

**“JUDGE NOT ACCORDING TO THE APPEARANCE,
BUT JUDGE RIGHTEOUS JUDGMENT”**

St. John 7:24 (KJV)

The greatest act of racism at work today is abortion. It has become a part of the systemic legislative apparatus in contemporary society and an acceptable norm in healthcare under the guise of “Family Planning.”

The inculcation of abortion as a legislative and legal necessity has been centralized as a practice into Planned Parenthood’s family management strategy. The founder and eugenicist, Margaret Sanger, mother of modern-day population control and founder of *The American Birth Control League*, which evolved into what is now known as Planned Parenthood, have influenced an army across the globe to embrace race management or race mitigation.
