



The Northern District Council elections are scheduled to take place in Jackson, Michigan at our annual summer June 2022 session.

Due to the Covid-19 pandemic the NDC has been unable to hold in-person council sessions for the past two years. Because of this, executive decisions have been made to restructure voting guidelines, as well as methods of voting for the general body and all auxiliaries.

Please read carefully below for all procedures, guidelines, and requirements.

Voting Methods

OPTION #1 Onsite Ballot Voting (*Projected days & times ONLY, final schedule posted by June 1)

- * GENERAL BODY: Voting on Thursday and Friday ONLY: 10:00am 4:30pm
- * NDCMMA (MEN MINISTRY) Voting on Friday ONLY: 10:00am 4:30pm
- * NDCMCWA (MISSIONARY/WOMEN) Voting on Tuesday and Wednesday ONLY: 10:00am 4:30pm
- * NDCUB (USHER BOARD) Voting on Thursday ONLY: 10:00am 4:30pm
- * NDCSPA (SINGLE PEOPLE'S ALLIANCE) Voting on Friday ONLY: 10:00am 4:30pm
- * NDCMWMW (MINISTERS WIVES & WIDOWS) Voting on Thursday "IN PERSON" ONLY: 11:00am 1:30pm
- * NDCCEA (CHRISTIAN EDUCATION) Voting on Saturday ONLY: 9:30am 12:00pm
- * NDCPYPU (YOUNG PEOPLE) Voting on Saturday ONLY: 1:00pm 4:00pm

OPTION #2 Mail-in Ballot Voting (By request only March 22-26)

Should be for such sincere and genuine individuals/Saints: such as seniors or Fathers and Mothers of seniority age; the incapacitated or those who CANNOT for some unfortunate reasons truly arrive to the NDC for On-Site voting. Ballots must be requested between March 22-26 during the council session by contacting the registration desk or filling out an online form request between March 27 through April 30th. Ballots will be mailed to delegates on May 9 and must be returned by June 10th. No mail-in ballots will be accepted if postmarked after June 10th. All specific requirements below must be met to request and receive mail in ballot. All invalid mail-in ballots will be NOT be counted and rejected.

• Guidelines For Voting (General Body & All Auxiliaries)

- * #1 ALL VOTERS must be registered with the General Body for the March 2022 & June 2022 council session.

 (If requesting a mail-in ballot, the delegate must preregister for the June council at the March session to be eligible to receive ballot in mail)
- * #2 ALL VOTERS must be a member of the council and possess a NDC Membership Card (CURRENT), in order to vote. Each card holder has a member #, this will be used for verification to prevent duplicity.

 (NDC PYPU will be exempt from this requirement unless they are on the ballot to become an officer)
 - * If delegate has lost or misplaced their Membership Card (used in order to vote), you can purchase a replacement card through registration before in-person voting .

* #3 Additional Auxiliary Requirements:

- * MCWA must be registered with MCWA for March & June 2022 council sessions and have a MCWA membership card. (*Please see the MCWA secretary*)
- * MEN'S MINISTRY, CHRISTIAN EDUCATION ASSOC., & SINGLES ALLIANCE
 - must be registered for the March 2022 & June 2022 sessions with their respective auxiliary.
- * VOTERS can only Vote by one (1) Method: In-Person or by Mail-In (REQUEST ONLY).
- * The Compliance Department shall have the authority to intervene and make RECOMMENDATIONS on all issues pertaining to ELECTIONS.
- * The Bishop of the Diocese will have the Final Authority to act as he may determine.



Membership, Fellowship Certificate, and License Guidelines

APPLICATION

FOR NEW MEMBERSHIP

- 1. Application forms must be filled out with your pastor's signature.
- 2. Fee: \$40.00; renewable every 2 years (June Council).
 Fee is \$20.00 after first
- 3. Member will receive a council card; it will be valid for two years. Replacement cards are \$1.00.
- 4. At each Council, members will register and receive a program and ribbon.
- 5. The registration fee is \$10.00.

APPLICATION

FOR FELLOWSHIP PAPERS

- 1. Anyone applying for Fellowship papers must be saved at least 4 years, or 3 years if the applicant has taken the Aenon Bible course.
- 2. Applicant must be a council member.
- 3. Fellowship papers must be filled out with your pastor's signature.
- 4. Papers must be given to the Credentials Committee between designated hours.
- 5. Applicant must show membership card upon meeting the Credentials Committee.
- 6. Fellowship papers must be renewed yearly. Fee: \$25.00

APPLICATION

FOR LICENSE

- 1. To be licensed you must have passed the Ministerial Introduction course from Aenon Bible College (either through a correspondence/ online/satellite course from Aenon Bible College or by attending an onsite class in Indiana).
- 2. Must be in good standing with local church for at least one year, and held Fellowship papers for one year.
- 3. The member should submit a Certificate of Completion to the Credentials Committee on designated Li-cense & Credentials posted times during the council session.

 4. Applicant will be tested.

 5. License must be renewed yearly.


